# **ABBEY ROAD - 50 YEARS LATER**

Classic Albums Live is a celebration of the most influential albums in recent music history. Tonight's concert features *Abbey Road*, by The Beatles. *Abbey Road* was released on September 26, 1969 by Apple Records and is the eleventh studio album (last to be produced, but not last to be released) by The Beatles. It is also the last album where all four Beatles were present during recording sessions: John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr. *Abbey Road* takes inspiration from the blues, progressive rock, and pop genres and is famous for its usage of a Moog synthesizer and Leslie speaker: a combination of a loudspeaker and an amplifier. Band member Paul McCartney said there is no theme to the album:

"I don't like people explaining albums. The only way you can explain it is to hear it. You can't really use words about music, otherwise we'd do a talking album. The album is the explanation, and it's up to you to make what you want of it. There is no theme to Abbey Road. There never is a theme to any of our albums, although some people saw one in Sgt. Pepper."-PAUL MCCARINEY, 1969

Abbey Road came out to mixed critical reviews, including ones questioning the authenticity of the album and the usage of artificial effects. However, the album was a huge success and became number one in the United Kingdom and the United States, and still remains as one of the most important albums ever created.

What is it that makes Abbey Road a masterpiece? Well, the breadth of the musical vision, the sheer scale of the band's collective musical imagination, and the audacity of it all, at a time when The Beatles were coming to the end of their time together.
