LIVING BLUES LEGEND

George “Buddy” Guy is a blues guitarist and singer from Lettsworth, Louisiana. He is famous for his sound that is inspired by both the traditions of classic Chicago blues as well as elements of rock and roll. He has influenced numerous artists, such as Eric Clapton, Stevie Ray Vaughan, and John Mayer. It is said that Buddy Guy first learned to play on a homemade instrument with two strings made from wire and tin cans. His first commercial breakthrough was with *Damn Right, I’ve Got the Blues* in 1991, and since then his name has been a major one in contemporary blues. He won the American Blues Foundation’s W.C. Handy Award 23 times, has six Grammy awards (most recently for his album *Living Proof* in 2011), and received the National Medal of the Arts in 2003. Buddy Guy was introduced into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 2005 and Louisiana Music hall of Fame in 2008, and has also been honoured at the Kennedy Center Honors (2012), an annual celebration of performing artists with lifetime contributions to American culture.

IN MUSIC MAGAZINE *ROLLING STONE*, BUDDY GUY WAS RANKED 23RD IN A LIST OF THE “100 GREATEST GUITARISTS OF ALL TIME” (2015). HIS SONG “STONE CRAZY” ALSO RANKED 78TH IN A LIST OF THE “100 GREATEST GUITAR SONGS OF ALL TIME” BY THE SAME MAGAZINE (2008).
