13-MILE SNAKE RIVER SCENIC FLOAT TRIP WITH TETON VIEWS



TRIP DETAILS:

The magnificent Teton Range sets the stage for our 13 mile Scenic Float. This trip is guide-powered so guests can relax and enjoy views all around. This 13-mile stretch is home to an array of natural wonders unlike anywhere else on earth and the opportunity to view them all in one place is extremely rare. Guests are welcome to bring cameras or use our complimentary binoculars. The afternoon trip includes a deli box lunch served on the river while you float. Lunches are provided by a local restaurant here in Jackson Hole so please notify us in advance of any food allergies. This trip features our full-sized AIRE inflatable, self-bailing, 18'3" raft. It can seat up to 12 people but we average 8 to 10 guests per boat. All positions in this raft are non-paddling positions.

Our experienced and knowledgeable guides will navigate you through this pristine landscape, sharing the history, geology, and wildlife of the region. You may see beaver, cutthroat trout, cliff swallows, pelicans, osprey and bald eagles on your trip. A lucky few may even catch a glimpse of a mule deer, moose, elk or even a grizzly or black bear.

BEST SUITED FOR:

The scenic float trip is best suited for families with kiddos ages 4 years or older, mature travelers, wildlife enthusiasts or birders, large groups and multi-generational travelers. All our float trips are a great way for any size of group to get out and enjoy nature together.

OVERVIEW OF THE SNAKE RIVER:

People come from all over the world to experience our newly designated "Wild and Scenic" river. The Snake River in Jackson Hole has been classified as a class I-III river, meaning that you can enjoy anything from a flat water scenic float in the north, to exciting whitewater rapids in the Snake River Canyon to the south.

CHECK-IN & TRANSPORTATION:

This trip requires check-in 30 minutes prior to launch time. The check-in location is at Mad River located at 1255 S HWY 89, just 2 miles south of the town square, between Whole Grocer and Smith's Grocery. Transportation from the Mad River boathouse to the river and back is provided on every Mad River trip.

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING:

- Dress in layers
- Shoes that can get wet (and won't fall off-no flip flops!)
- Snacks/water bottle for your bus to and from the river
- Hats and sunglasses are recommended
- Don't forget sunscreen!

COURSE OF TRIP:

This trip starts west of Jackson Hole (near Teton Village) and launches from the Wilson Bridge Boat Ramp, and winds its way south exiting the river at South Park Boat Ramp. Guests travel 13 river miles from start to finish.
