TETON VISA ATV (HALF DAY) & SUPER SMALL BOATS ... THE ULTIMATE ADVENTURE!





TRIP DETAILS:

Begin Begin the morning by driving north out of Jackson along the National Elk Refuge and then head east, deep into the Gros Ventre Valley where you'll begin your morning ATV Tour. Enjoy a scenic ride along the river in this remote area and a lunch break along the trail. Excellent Teton Range views (weather permitting) and multiple photo opportunities are the highlights of this trip. Following your morning ATV Tour, depart for an exhilarating ride on the smallest raft on the Snake River and enjoy a gourmet prepared right on the river. Run the class II and III rapids of the Snake River Canyon in our Super Small Boats. With 6 passengers in our smallest boat, guests can expect to feel every whitewater rapid. The river trip launches from West Table Boat Ramp in the Snake River Canyon and winds its way south toward Alpine, WY, exiting the river at Sheep Gulch Boat Ramp. Guests travel 8 river miles from start to finish. There are about 8 sets of rapids, ranging from class I to III. Rapids include Station Creek, Double Draw, Blind Canyon, Big Kahuna, Lunchcounter, Ropes, Champagne, and Cottonwoods

BEST SUITED FOR:

This combination trip is best suited for fit adults, honeymooners, brocations or adventure enthusiast. Mad River's recommendation is that all participants should be physically fit, able to paddle and ready for a challenge. Although the minimum age for Mad River's whitewater trips is 6 years old, this ride is suggested for kiddos 13 years and older.

OVERVIEW OF THE SNAKE RIVER:

People come from all over the world to experience our newly designated "Wild and Scenic" river. The Snake River in Jackson Hole has been classified as a class I-III river, meaning that you can enjoy anything from a flat water scenic float in the north, to exciting whitewater rapids in the Snake River Canyon to the south.

CHECK-IN & TRANSPORTATION:

Pick up and drop off at guest place of lodging is complimentary and is 30 to 60 minutes prior to departure depending on location.

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING:

- Long pants & close-toed shoes for ATV ride
- Synthetic layers and a bathing suit
- Shoes that can get wet (and won't fall off-no flip flops!)
- Snacks/water bottle for your bus to and from the river
- Hats and sunglasses are recommended
- Camera for the flight
- Don't forget sunscreen!
