13-MILE SCENIC FLOAT WITH TETON VIEWS + GRAND TETON SUNSET WILDLIFE TOUR

TRIP DETAILS:

The magnificent Teton Range sets the stage for our 13-mile Scenic Float trips. This trip starts west of the town of Jackson and winds its way south through braided river channels and sand bars. This 13-mile stretch is home to an array of birds and other wildlife. Due to calm waters, cameras and binoculars are generally fine for this stretch of river. You may see beaver, cutthroat trout, cliff swallows, pelicans, osprey and bald eagles on your trip. A lucky few may even catch a glimpse of a mule deer, moose, elk or even a grizzly or black bear. All positions in this raft are non-paddling positions. Simply relax and take in the beautiful scenery and wildlife views all around you.

After returning from the scenic float, your wildlife tour guide picks you up at the Mad River boathouse. For the remainder of the afternoon you will be whisked away to roam the antelope flats north of Jackson Hole in search of bison and other big Wyoming game. Experience a bit of Jackson Hole history at the Shane Cabins and see what early life in Jackson Hole might have been like. Stop for dinner on the deck with spectacular views of Jackson Lake and the stunning Teton Range at Signal Mountain Lodge. After dinner, make your way back to Jackson Hole along the wooded Moose- Wilson road, prime habitat for the North American Moose.

The Snake River Canyon and the National Park are rich in geological history and your professional and experienced guides will point some the features that make the vast area unique. They will share the history of the area as well as information about the incredible local flora and fauna.

BEST SUITED FOR:

This combination trip is best suited for families with kiddos ages 4 years or older, mature travelers, wildlife enthusiast or birders, small to mid-sized groups and multigenerational travelers. This combination trip is a great way for any size of group to get out and enjoy nature together.

OVERVIEW OF THE SNAKE RIVER:

People come from all over the world to experience our newly designated "Wild and Scenic" river. The Snake River in Jackson Hole has been classified as a class I-III river, meaning that you can enjoy anything from a flat water scenic float in the north, to exciting whitewater rapids in the Snake River Canyon to the south.

CHECK-IN & TRANSPORTATION:

Pick up and drop off at guest place of lodging is complimentary and is 30 to 60 minutes prior to departure depending on location.

WHAT TO WEAR/BRING:

- Dress in layers
- Comfortable clothes and jacket for Wildlife tour
- Shoes that can get wet (and won't fall off-no flip flops!)
- Snacks/water bottle for your bus to and from the river
- Hats and sunglasses are recommended
- Camera for the float
- Don't forget sunscreen!
