HORSE CREEK MESA RIDE (2HR) & CLASSIC 8-MILE SNAKE RIVER WHITEWATER





TRIP DETAILS:

Pair your horseback ride with a thrilling whitewater experience! In the morning, depart on a backcountry trail ride with experienced guides. Take in the serenity of the Gros Ventre Wilderness with breathtaking views of the Teton Range. Horses are well mannered, strong and mountain-wise. Then, head on down the Snake River Canyon for whitewater thrills. Our professional guides will educate you on the flora and fauna and history of the great Snake River, here in Jackson Hole, all while providing whitewater fun from start to finish. The river trip launches from West Table Boat Ramp in the Snake River Canyon and winds its way south toward Alpine, WY, exiting the river at Sheep Gulch Boat Ramp. Guests travel 8 river miles from start to finish. There are about 8 sets of rapids, ranging from class I to III. Rapids include Station Creek, Double Draw, Blind Canyon, Big Kahuna, Lunchcounter, Ropes, Champagne, and Cottonwoods.

BEST SUITED FOR:

This combination trip is best suited for families with kiddos 7 and up, all adults or small to medium sized groups.

OVERVIEW OF THE SNAKE RIVER:

People come from all over the world to experience our newly designated "Wild and Scenic" river. The Snake River in Jackson Hole has been classified as a class I-III river, meaning that you can enjoy anything from a flat water scenic float in the north, to exciting whitewater rapids in the Snake River Canyon to the south.

CHECK-IN & TRANSPORTATION:

A transfer is required between horseback ride and whitewater trip and is located only 9 miles or 15 minutes south of town. Transportation from the Mad River boathouse to the river and back is provided on every Mad River trip.

- Hats and sunglasses are recommended
- Camera for the flight
- Don't forget sunscreen!
