**Discovery Area:** Learn about our smaller animals as you explore this space, a comfortable walk for all guests. The area features educational signage with species information, animal biographies, and rescue stories. Special educational talks on enrichment, species, conservation and other topics may also be available here; check our website calendar for updates.

Guided Tours: Included with standard admission, our knowledgeable guides will take you on a ½ mile walk past our big cats and bears while telling their individual stories, and what we can do together to protect wildlife for the future. \*Trolley service available.

Day Camps: Fun filled adventures for children ages 6-12 years. They'll enjoy the wonders of the Refuge and experience the world of big cats, while learning about animal husbandry and how to become young wildlife advocates!

**Workshops:** Join our Wildlife Interpreters as they explore native and exotic wildlife and enjoy hands-on activities such as making enrichment for our animals during team-building workshops.

Offsite Outreach: Can't make it to the Refuge? Our team will develop a content specific presentation tailored to your group's age, needs and interests. The animals do not travel; they stay safely in their home at TCWR. But we have a plethora of educational tools such as replica teeth, claws, and other items to touch and inspire learning with. \*Subject to off-site fee, fundraising available.
