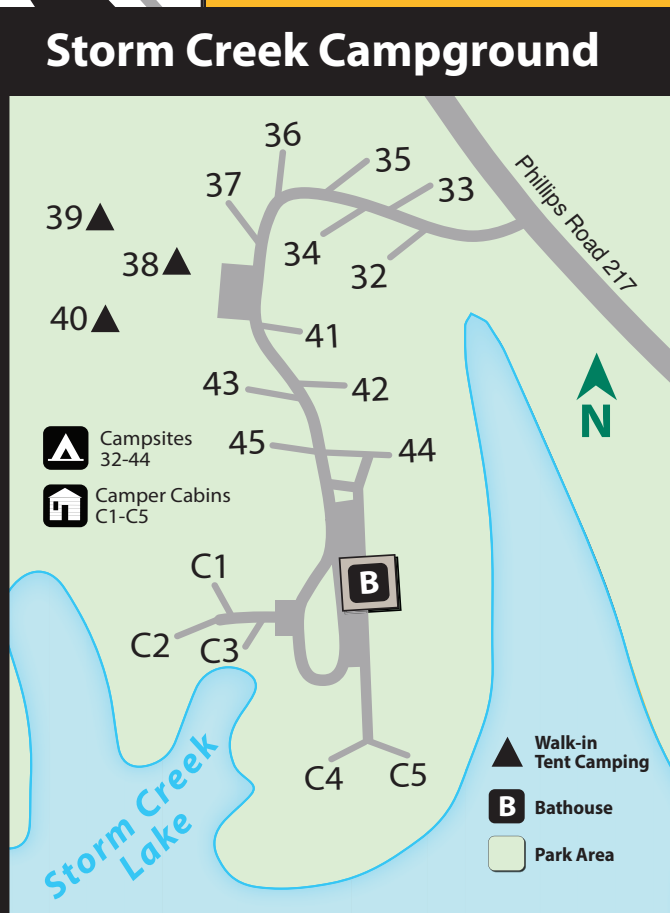
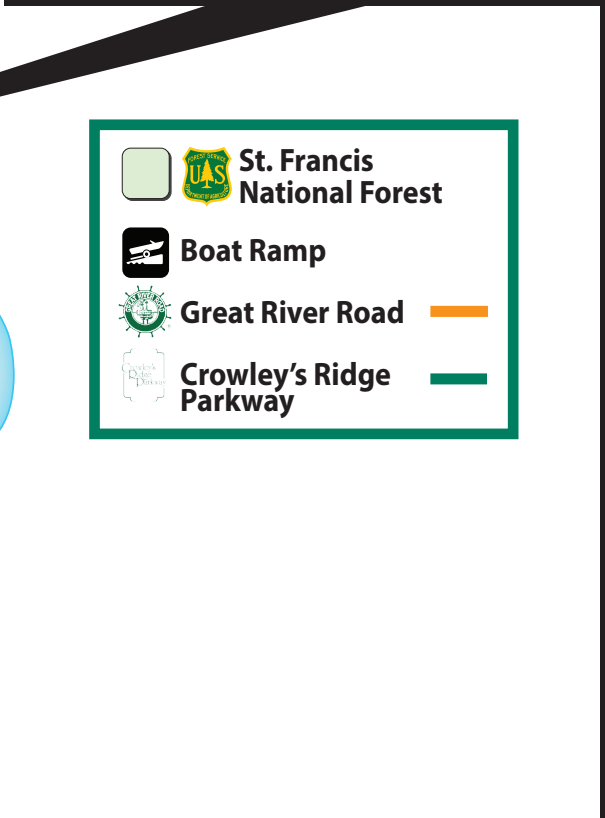
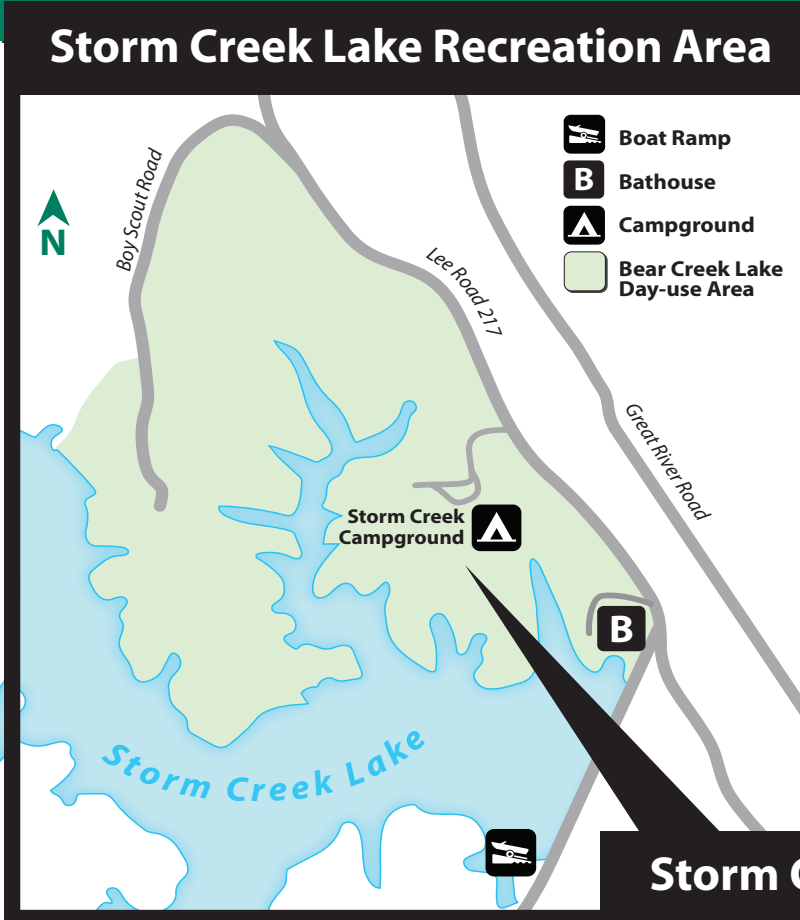
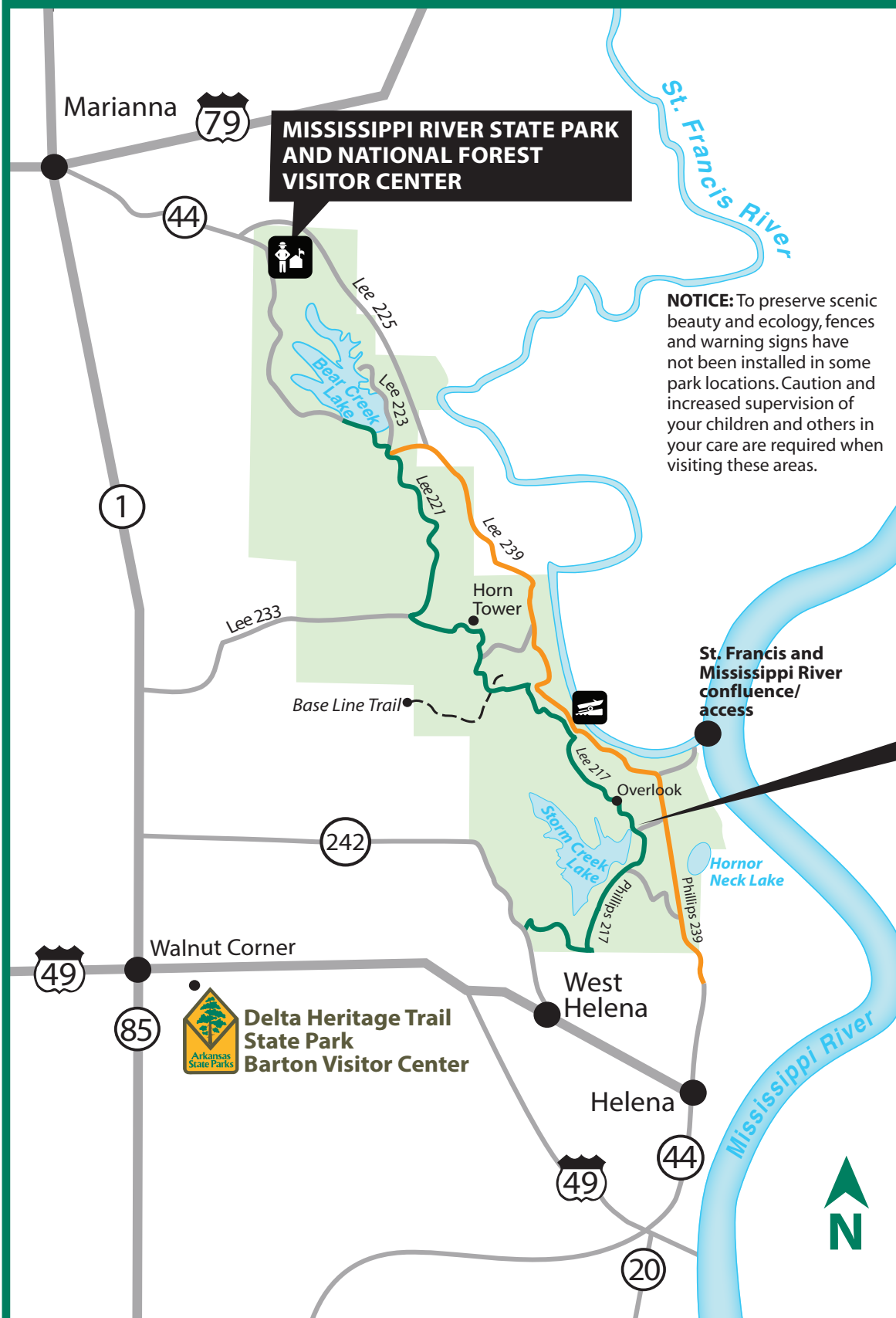




# MISSISSIPPI RIVER STATE PARK

## CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

- Quiet hours are 10 p.m. to sunrise (Includes generators)**
- Don't bring firewood.**  
Non-native pests and diseases can be transported long distances in firewood. These transported pests and diseases can eliminate entire species of trees and do considerable damage to our forest. Be a responsible steward of your natural resources: Leave firewood at home – do not transport it to campgrounds. Use firewood from local sources.
- No ATVs are allowed in the forest or park.**
- No fireworks are allowed in the forest or park.**
- Keep your pet leashed.**
- No hunting within state park boundaries.**  
**NOTICE:** With the establishment of Mississippi River State Park, within the National Forest, the hunting access around all recreational areas has changed slightly. You are encouraged to stay and hunt the National Forest, but please be mindful that certain state park areas are closed to hunting. Boundaries at Bear Creek Lake are marked with this sign (at right). Please do not dress or display game at the campground. If you have questions, please contact the state park offices at (870) 295-4040.



**10 HP** Motors over 10 horsepower are prohibited. Options for disabling your boat motor include:

- complete removal of the propeller
- removal of the fuel line
- removal of at least one spark plug or spark plug wire
