★ Habitat Tour 1/2 Mile

Starting at 10am (summer) or 11am (winter) each day, Turpentine Creek offers a guided tour of our natural habitats. The 1/2 mile walking tour is guided by one of our biologist or zoologist interns.

The intern educates the public about the refuge, the different species of animals, and each enclosure. Information is provided about rescues, construction, and donations in order to keep the facility expanding. This is a great opportunity to watch the big cats running, playing, and stalking: just like they would in the wild. The tours run every hour, on the hour, until 4pm (summer) or 3pm (winter). We also offer guided trolley tours during the summer, that run along the same path as the guided-walking tour path for an additional \$5 per person. Trolley Tours leave every hour, on the half hour, starting at 10:30am until 3:30 pm. Trolley tours are not available in the winter.
