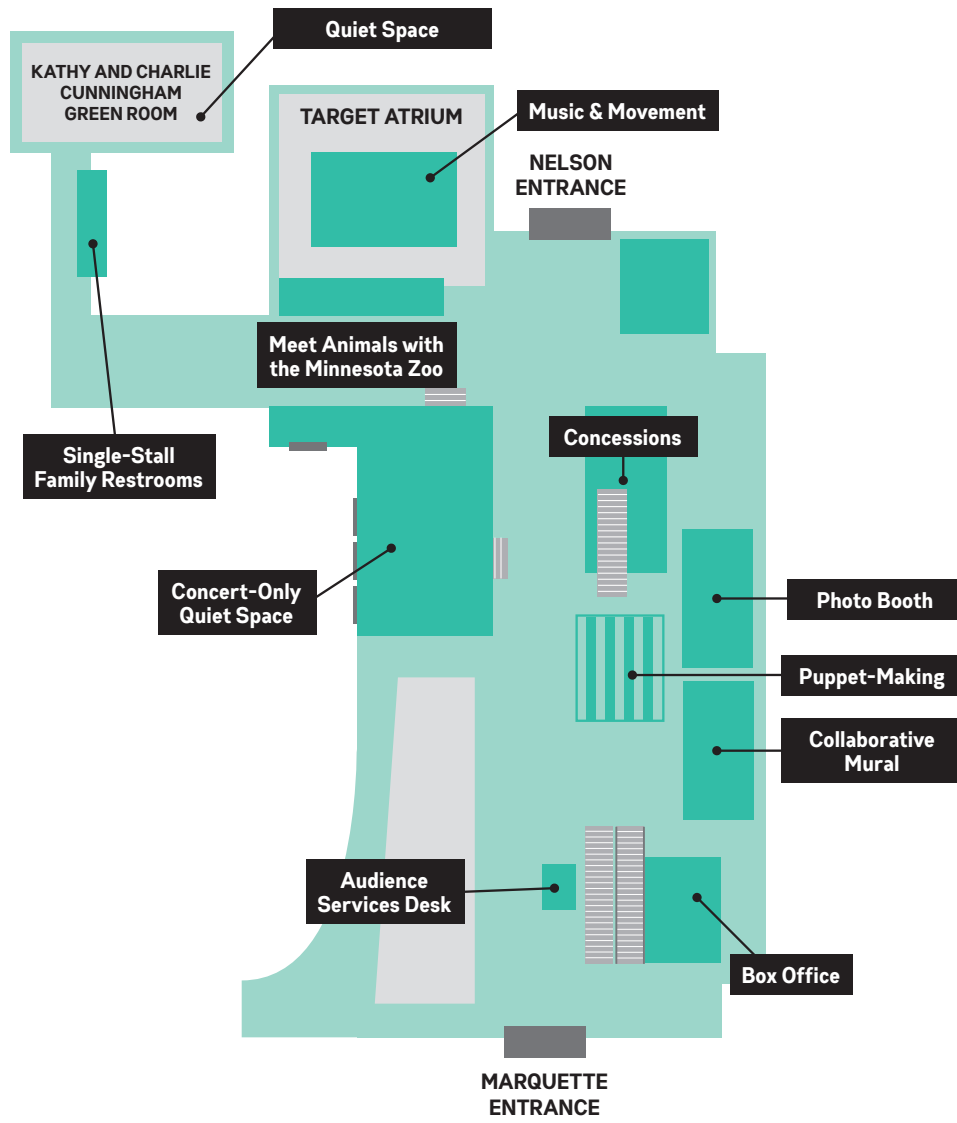

Quiet Space

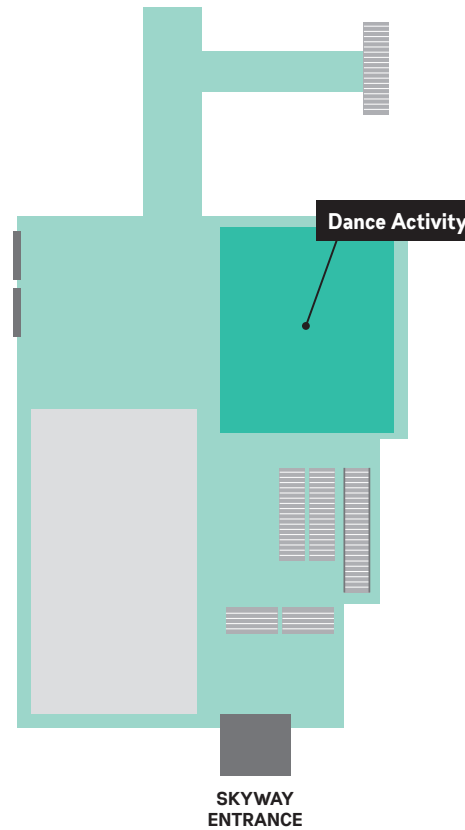

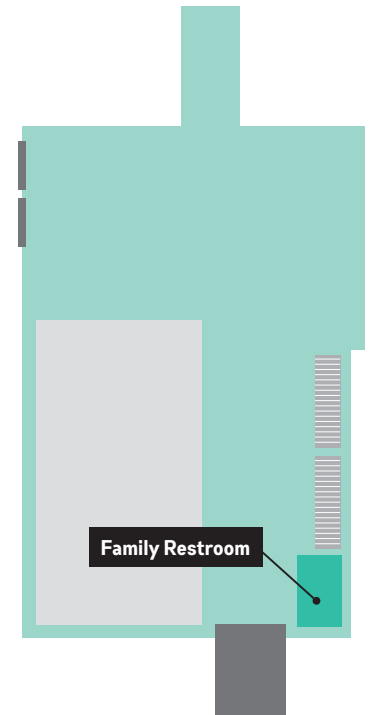
