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YOUNG LEADERS PROGRAM



Minus18 is Australia's charity improving the lives of LGBTQIA+ young people. This year we launched the Young Leaders Program - a 10 month course for 20 LGBTQIA+ youth aged 18-25.

Through fortnightly development sessions the Young Leaders grow their personal leadership, community connection and work-readiness then put these skills into practice through the creation of their own spaces and programs.

Ultimately, the program is designed to build the skills, confidence and social connection of 20 LGBTQIA+ youth — increasing their workreadiness and connection to opportunities that extend well after the program.

9 Events were held by the Young Leaders for 1,610 LGBTQIA+ youth.

100% had employment of any kind after the program. Only 39% did before.

WHY WE CREATED IT





of LGBTQIA+ Youth experience harassment or discrimination due to their LGBTQIA+ identity at school, work, at home or on the street.



This leads to LGBTQIA+ youth experiencing higher rates of homelessness, social isolation, depression, anxiety and unemployment.



The Young Leaders program has been designed to give young people the skills, confidence and social support to overcome these - giving access to employment and leadership opportunities.



THE YOUNG PEOPLE

20 Young Leaders were selected from a total of 54 applications based on their experience working in groups and their demonstrated need and desire for leadership development and social connection.

LGBTQIA+ Young people with intersecting identities were prioritised for the first year program, as research demonstrates this cohort are more at risk of experiencing harassment, discrimination and isolation.

THE PROGRAM - LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT



YOUNG PEOPLE GREW THER LEADERSHIP SKILLS DURING THE PROGRAM

Across 10 months the Young Leaders attended fortnightly leadership development sessions to improve their skill and confidence as an emerging leader.

These sessions ranged from crafting a safe personal narrative, exploring queer history and receiving tangible career advice from LGBTQIA+ professionals. Each Young Leader received an honorarium payment to attend these session.



19 Leadership Sessions were delivered with:



350 instances of participation;

700 hours of leadership development in total.



The Inclusive Leadership session was led by the Victorian Commissioner for LGBTQIA+ Communities, Todd Fernando, exploring inclusive advocacy and allyship.



The **Oucer Carcers** session shared presentations and insights on the experiences of queer professionals forging resilient careers.

The Careers Session Was My Highlight Of The Program

For the first time I actually saw so much of myself in a bunch of adults talking about the workforce. I really connected to everyone when they were sharing their lived experience. I felt connected to the people within Minus18, not just the org.

THEY PUT THESE NEW SKILLS INTO ACTION THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

Young Leaders put their new leadership skills and confidence into practice by engaging in lifeaffirming events for LGBTQIA+ youth at Minus18.

From digital livestreams to facilitated activities, and even emceeing on stage, the young leaders were inspiring representation for the youth attendees.

Additionally, Young Leaders contributed their voice to major youth projects with other organisations, ranging from assessing grants and youth engagement with Vichealth, to participating in roundtable consultations on the digital future for young people within the Metaverse.

Young Leaders received payment for their involvement in all of these opportunities.

The Youth Panel for IDAHOBIT was designed and delivered entirely by the young leaders - celebrating everyday queer excellence at the Victorian Pride Centre.
