










2024 Impact Summary



We Provided Free Flag Raising Ceremony Packs To 300 Schools

This year we grew our support of young people across the country by providing free Flag Raising Ceremony Packs – with everything needed for schools to host their own flag raising ceremony event!

This year:

- → 300 schools received a free pack, thanks to Ampol Foundation – who also helped us pack these packs!
- → That's over **123,000 students** supported across Australia!

We Delivered Education Sessions To 6,007 People

It's not enough to simply create our own safe spaces for LGBTQIA+ youth - we host keynotes, workshops and training sessions to empower schools and workplaces to be LGBTQIA+ inclusive spaces too.

This year:

- → 6,007 people attended LGBTQIA+ education including digital events, keynotes and private training.
- ightarrow 94% would recommend these sessions to others.

And Inspired 5,568 Schools & Workplaces To Host Activities

We inspire schools and workplaces to sign up to host an activity to celebrate IDAHOBIT in 2023, providing the tools to make long lasting change.

This year:

- ightarrow 5568 schools, workplaces and groups signed up.
- ightarrow 200 people on average attended each activity.
- → That's 1.1 million people in total!

It's not JUST about awareness though:

 \rightarrow 93% said celebrating IDAHOBIT helped to created ongoing LGBTQIA+ inclusion beyond the day.

- → They were used right across the country in a range of different places – like schools, offices, hotels, and local swimming pools!
