Are you excited to grow your unique skills, make a real impact, and connect with your community? The Minus18 Young Leaders Program is designed just for you!

Join us for a 10-month journey from October 2024 to August 2025, where you'll participate in fortnightly sessions aimed at building your confidence, honing your skills, and gaining valuable experience. You'll play a key role in our life-affirming events, including the Melbourne Queer Formal, and inspire the next generation of LGBTQIA+ youth.

We're looking for 20 enthusiastic young leaders to take part in our Melbourne-based program.

ABOUT MINUS18

Minus18 is Australia's charity improving the lives of LGBTQIA+ youth. We support LGBTQIA+ young people through events and digital platforms, and provide fee for service LGBTQIA+ inclusion training to schools, businesses and community organisations. Since 2011 over 100,000 young people have engaged in these services across Melbourne, Sydney and Adelaide, and millions more via digital platforms.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Who	We're recruiting 20 LGBTQIA+ young people aged 18 - 25
Duration	10 months
Start Date	Tuesday, 22 October 2025
Sessions	Each session, or 'QLAB,' will run for 2 hours every fortnight on Tuesdays (5-7pm), with occasional weekend availability required for Minus18 events. To ensure Young Leaders fully benefit from the program, an 85% attendance rate is required for graduation
Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Improved connection to the LGBTQIA+ community• Increased confidence as a leader• Strengthened professional and personal development• Increased confidence in employability• Positive progress in career or educational pathways
Location	Minus18 Office, at the Victorian Pride Centre, 79-81 Fitzroy St, St Kilda VIC. Additionally, this role will include some engagement at Minus18's Melbourne-based events. Some QLAB may be delivered online
Access	This program will primarily be located at the Victorian Pride Centre in St Kilda; an exciting, purpose-built space for LGBTQIA+ community organisations. This space includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A raised Tram Stop within 100m of the building entrance• All gender, accessible bathrooms• Elevators• Dedicated prayer / mindfulness room
Appreciation	Young Leaders will be provided a \$50 honorarium after attending each scheduled QLAB Session or Event to cover travel and other associated costs

- > Looking to grow your personal leadership skills as an LGBTQIA+ young person
- > A good communicator and works collaboratively
- > Available Tuesdays from 5pm - 7pm
- > Willing to engage with and develop leadership skills and confidence
- > Passionate about helping LGBTQIA+ youth through programs and events
- > Able to commit to the duration of the 10 month program



WHAT YOU'LL BE DOING

1. TRAINING AND UPSKILLING

This pillar is all about you and your development as a leader. We'll design QLABs that provide you with the opportunity to understand and find confidence with your own leadership style, to build on the skills you have, and learn more about leadership in the LGBTQIA+ sector.

We'll explore things like:

- How can I make spaces more inclusive, and why is that important?
- What does safe and effective LGBTQIA+ advocacy look like?
- How do I safely share my experience as a queer person? (at work, at home, wherever!)

These QLABs will be guided by Minus18 staff and feature special guests from the LGBTQIA+ community, who are leaders within their field.



2. CREATING AND IMPLEMENTING

This is where you'll get to be part of the team that delivers Minus18's life-affirming in-person and digital youth events. You'll work with the Minus18 Youth Programs Team to provide on-the-ground support at events, and implement those leadership skills that you'll be working on within the program!

Events include:

- Melbourne Queer Formal
- Night at the Museum
- Midsumma's Pride March
- A Young Leader-led event for IDAHOBIT
- Digital events such as Virtual Chill Out
- And MORE!!

3. SOCIALISING AND CONNECTING

This is your chance to connect with the community. Alongside valuable opportunities to upskill and learn from expert guests, the Young Leaders Program offers engaging and interactive social QLABs where you can build meaningful connections with fellow participants.

For many, this program is not only a way to connect with others but also a powerful opportunity to explore and deepen their understanding of their own identities.

HOW TO APPLY

INSTRUCTIONS



Record a short video (maximum 2 minutes) introducing yourself, and what you're hoping to get out of Minus18's Young Leaders Program. Creativity is encouraged but not required!



Have a think about these three questions you will be asked during the application:

- What are you hoping to get out of the Young Leaders Program? (max. 200 words)
- What does queer leadership mean to you? (max. 200 words)
- Describe a time when you faced a challenge in a team setting. How did you handle conflict or differing opinions, and what actions did you take to overcome the challenge? Please provide a specific example. (max 200. words)

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I APPLY?

We'll review all the applications and create a shortlist for interviews.

Shortlisted candidates will be involved in a small group interview with the team and other potential applicants. This interview helps us learn more about you and give you an opportunity to meet the other candidates. These will be conducted online.

FAQS & OTHER DETAILS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I'm 17 but I turn 18 during the program, can I still apply?

Yes! We love your enthusiasm, but remember if you become a Young Leader you won't be able to attend Minus18 events as an attendee.

I'm turning 26 during the program, can I still apply?

Yes, if you think the program is the right fit for you, get that application in!

Will I still be able to attend Minus18 events as an attendee, with my friends?

No, if you become a Young Leader you will not be able to attend Minus18 events as an attendee. If you'd still like to attend our events, we encourage you to wait another year before applying.

Will I need to travel interstate for Minus18 events outside Victoria?

No, this is a Victorian based program and all events will be based in Melbourne and surrounds.

I live outside Victoria, can I still apply for the program?

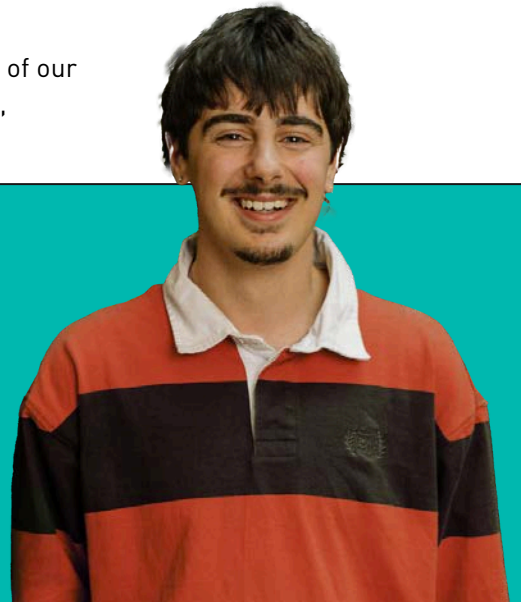
Unfortunately not, this program is only open for people living in Vic. If you live in NSW or SA you can apply to volunteer at one of our interstate events!

Do I need to have a background in events or event planning?

Not at all! This is a leadership development program with opportunities to support Minus18 events and practice your leadership skills. You're not expected to plan events. While Young Leaders will get the chance to lead the planning of one event during the program, you'll work closely with our events team, and they'll handle the heavy lifting!

Is this a leadership program or a volunteering program?

It's both! Minus18 has reimagined volunteering. You'll support the delivery of our events while the program gives back to you, offering opportunities to learn, develop, and connect.
