

Awareness and Visibility

We build awareness of the 2 in 3 LGBTQIA+ youth who still experience abuse for who they are.

Our digital campaigns, partnerships and research create visibility for the inclusion of LGBTQIA+ youth.

LGBTQIA+ Education

Creating an Australia free from discrimination is a job for everyone.

We transform awareness into action through LGBTQIA+ training, workshops and resources that enable others to champion inclusivity – no matter their location.

Life-Affirming Programs

Our preventive model of mental health support tackles social isolation by creating spaces where LGBTQIA+ youth belong. Young people are at the forefront of our programs – and we're empowering them to be the next generation of LGBTQIA+ leaders.
