

Terms and Conditions:

2021 World Vision 40 Hour Famine Ambassador Meet & Greet Giveaway

- PROMOTER: The promoter of the competition is World Vision of New Zealand Trust Board (World Vision of New Zealand). Company number CC25984, having its registered office at 51 Hugo Johnston Drive, Penrose, Auckland 1061
- 2. ENTRY: To enter, participants must create an online fundraising profile at 40hour.org.nz and link to a school group or youth group prior to 11:59pm NZT Sunday 27th June 2021. To confirm competition entry, participants will receive an email week commencing 5th July 2021 asking them to submit an online form to confirm which one (1) of the three (3) prize draws they wish to enter. Participants must complete the online form contained in this email by 11:59pm NZT 18th July 2021 to confirm their entry into the prize draw.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

- a. Entries are not open to employees of World Vision New Zealand or employees' immediate family members. Immediate family constitutes of spouse, ex-spouse, defacto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
- b. Redemption of prizes will require all winners under 18 years of age to have parental/guardian consent. Failure to obtain parental/guardian consent will result in the prize being forfeited.
