Auditions will be held in Melbourne only. Graduates who are based interstate are welcome to apply. Selftape can be made available to those who cannot travel to Melbourne for the auditions.

Whilst not auditioning for a specific role or production, this is an opportunity for 2023 graduates to meet and share their work with Melbourne Theatre Company Casting Director, Janine Snape (she/her), Resident Director, Tasnim Hossain (she/her) and Casting Associate, Rhys Velasquez (they/she).

Whilst we endeavor to meet all graduates who meet the criteria, there are only limited spots available. Any graduate who cannot be seen in person will be asked to self-tape.

AUDITION INFORMATION

- This opportunity is specifically for graduates who completed their studies in 2023
- The audition duration will be 10 minutes only.
- There will be time to present two (2) short pieces. Performers should select pieces that best reflect their skills and interests. No piece should be longer than 2 ½ minutes.
- Performers may choose to perform a song as one of their pieces. This is encouraged for Musical Theatre performers. A piano will be available but artists need to provide their own accompanist or other form of accompaniment. Piano backing tracks are permitted. A Bluetooth sound system will be available for performers with backing tracks. If your device does not have Bluetooth access, please provide your own alternative speaker or audio.
- If performers wish to present a scene, they may bring another actor into the room to read opposite. Please note that the reader will not be considered.
- Once an audition date and time has been confirmed, it is unable to be changed.
- Auditions will take place at Melbourne Theatre Company Headquarters 252 Sturt Street, Southbank.
- Attendance at auditions is at the performer's own responsibility. Any costs incurred for attending the auditions are the sole responsibility of the artist and not the Company or Casting Department
