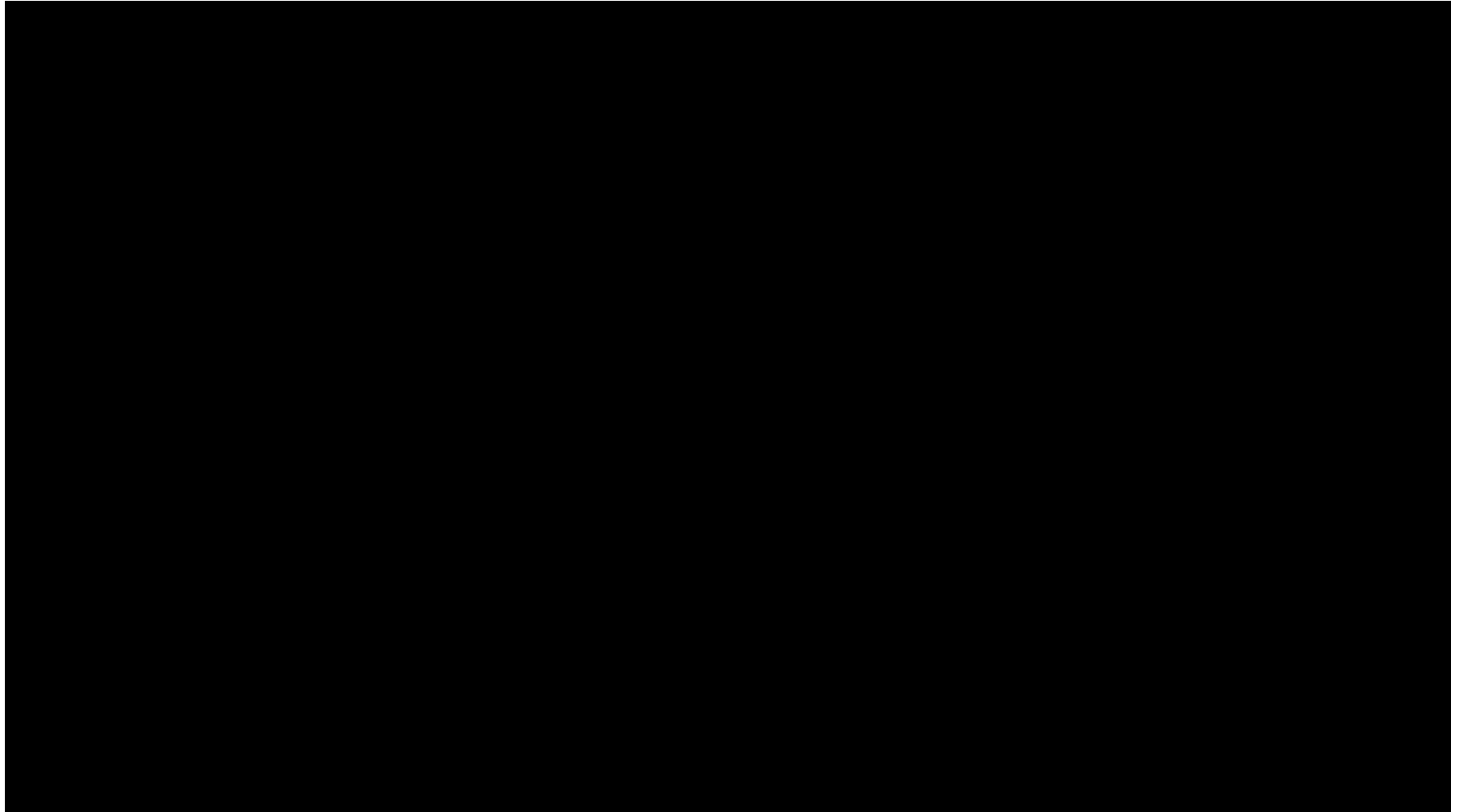




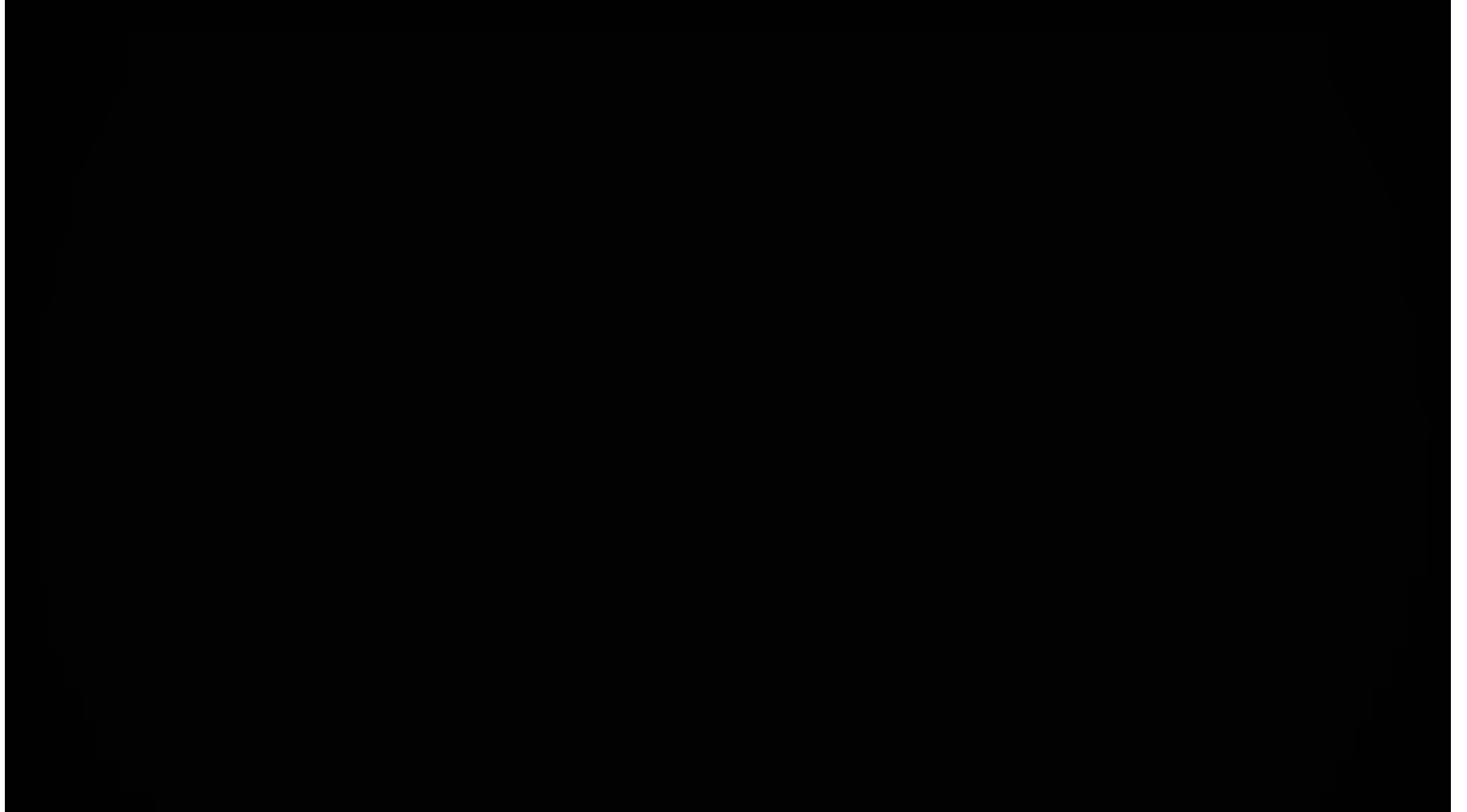
CHOOSING FRIENDS AT SCHOOL FACTORS




CONSEQUENCES OF BAD FRIENDSHIP (PROV.1:10; II THES. 3:6-13)
