The National Congress of American Indians Resolution #ANC-22-XXX

WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) was established in 1944 and is the oldest and largest national organization of American Indian and Alaska Native tribal governments; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) ...
