



- ✓ Recurring data calls on ARPA spending
- ✓ Option year contracts continue (Reserve)
- ✓ ARPA supports phased planning for K-12 (\$536m) and TCUs (\$229m)

Student Transportation

EPA Clean School Bus Program

Funding rounds and applications to continue 2023

- ✓ Provides rebates on electric school buses
- ✓ Vehicle swap outs of older vehicles or donations
- ✓ Charging infrastructure is included
- ✓ EPA approved vendors provide application support
- ✓ Up to \$375K per priority bus recipient (BIE schools)
- ✓ Up to \$20K in infrastructure support also available
