Overview



The compact smart speaker designed for room-filling sound

- Compact design fits beautifully on bookshelf, kitchen counter, nightstand, or mounted to a wall or stand.
- Flexible connectivity with WiFi, Bluetooth®, and USB-C line-in.
- Easy control using the Sonos app, your voice, or the intuitive touch controls.
- Pair two Era 100 speakers for an even wider soundstage, or use two as rear surrounds with the latest Sonos soundbars.
- See **Setup** when you're ready to add a Sonos Era 100 to your system.

Control and lights



Volume control

- Volume up (slide right or tap +)
- Volume down (slide left or tap -)

Note: To quickly change the volume, press and hold + or - .



Play/Pause

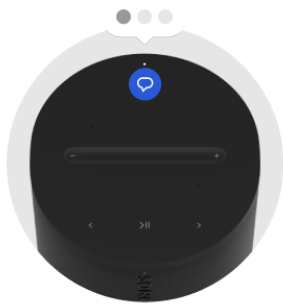
- Press once to play or pause audio.
- Press and hold to add the music that's playing in another room.



Next/Previous

- Press > to skip to the next song.
- Press < to go to the previous song.

Note: You can't skip forward or go back when listening to a radio station.



Voice services on/off

Press the microphone icon on top of the speaker to turn voice services on or off.

- When the indicator light is on, voice control is available (the microphone switch on the back must also be on).
- When the indicator light is off, voice control is off.

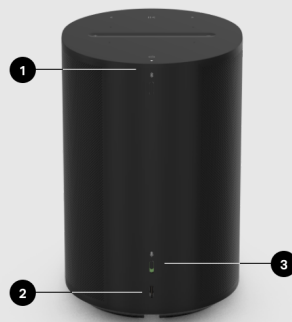


Status light

Displays the product's connection to WiFi, indicates when the volume is muted, and signals errors.

Bluetooth button

- Press and hold to pair a new device.
 - Press once to reconnect.

The USB-C port is designed for line-in and Ethernet connections using the Sonos Line-In Adapter or Combo Adapter (sold separately). It's not a power source for the speaker and shouldn't be used to charge other devices.

- **Ethernet:** Use the Sonos Combo Adapter and an Ethernet cable to connect Era 100 directly to your router if you want to hardwire your speaker (helpful if your WiFi is unstable).
- **Line-in:** Use either the Sonos Line-In Adapter or Combo Adapter to connect your turntable, CD player, or other device.

Toggle to turn all product microphones on or off.

- When the switch is off (down), the microphones are disabled so microphone-enabled features like Trueplay quick tuning and voice services are unavailable.
- When the switch is on (up), microphone-enabled features like Trueplay are available. (Voice services are available if the voice services indicator light on top of the product is also on.)

Note: To use voice services, both the microphone switch and the voice services indicator light must be on.

Select a location

You can put your speaker just about anywhere. For the best performance, here's a few guidelines:

- Era 100 is made to give you powerful sound anywhere—Trueplay tuning balances the sound for wherever it's placed, and whatever you're listening to.
- When Era 100 is placed next to a wall or on a shelf, leave at least 1" (2.5 cm) of space around the back of the speaker for best performance.
- If you're using Era 100 speakers as surrounds, leave at least 8" (203 mm) clearance around each speaker.

Bluetooth pairing

1. Turn Bluetooth on in your device settings.
2. Press and hold the Bluetooth button on the back on the speaker until you hear a tone, then release. The status light blinks blue when the speaker is ready to pair.
3. Choose **Sonos Era 100** from the list of available devices in your Bluetooth settings. Your mobile device will automatically connect next time.

Line-in

Microphone on/off

There are two ways to control the microphones on Era 100:

A universal microphone switch on the back of Era 100 turns all microphones on and off.

A voice services button on top of Era 100 turns voice services on and off without affecting the microphones needed for Trueplay and other microphone-dependent features.

- When both are on, voice control and all microphone-enabled features are available.
- When both are off, voice control and all microphone-enabled features are unavailable.
- When the universal microphone switch is on and the voice services light is off, Trueplay and other microphone-enabled features are available but voice control is off.

Voice services

Merk: Stemmestyring er foreløpig ikke støttet i alle land. Denne funksjonen blir tilgjengelig så snart Sonos og en stemmetjeneste lanseres sammen i regionen din.

Trueplay™

Trueplay tuning measures how sound reflects off walls, furnishings, and other surfaces in a room, then fine tunes your Sonos speaker to make sure it sounds great no matter where you place it.

During setup, choose the Trueplay option that works best for you and your space. To retune later, go to  > **System**, choose a room, and select **Trueplay**.

Advanced tuning

Advanced tuning is custom and precise. It takes about 5 minutes and uses the microphone on an iOS device (running iOS 8 or later) so you'll move around the room while the sound is fine tuned for your space.

Note: Advanced tuning is the best choice for large rooms (open concept spaces may experience less precise tuning).


Quick tuning

Quick tuning is fast, effortless, and accessible. It takes about a minute and uses the microphone on your Sonos product to detect the environment so there's no need to move around the room during tuning.

Note: Quick tuning is available for both iOS and Android, and is a good choice for smaller rooms, or spaces where it's difficult to move easily.

Auto Trueplay


Portable Sonos products like Sonos Roam and Move can tune themselves automatically. Auto Trueplay uses your speaker's microphone to detect the environment and make periodic tuning adjustments so you get great sound wherever your speaker is and whatever you're listening to.

Go to  > **System**, and select your portable speaker to turn on auto Trueplay.

Set up stereo pair


Par to Sonos-høytalere i samme rom for å oppnå en fyldigere stereoopplevelse. Én høyttaler fungerer som den venstre kanalen, og den andre som den høyre kanalen.

Merk: Sonos-høytalerne i stereoparet må være av samme type.

1. Plasser høyttalerne 2,5–3 meter unna hverandre. Lytteposisjonen bør være 2,5 til 3,5 meter unna de to høyttalerne. Hvis du er nærmere, hører du mer bass, og hvis du er lenger unna, får du bedre stereolyd.
2. Gå til  > **System..**
3. Velg en av høyttalerne du vil bruke i stereoparet, og velg deretter **Konfigurer et stereopar** for å komme i gang. [Finn ut mer](#)

Set up surrounds

Det er enkelt å forvandle to Sonos-høytalere (samme modell) eller en Sonos Amp og favoritt-høytalerne dine av et annet merke til henholdsvis høyre og venstre kanal i et hjemmekinoanlegg.

1. Plasser hver surroundhøytaler omtrent 3 m fra favorittlytteposisjonen din, og vend dem mot sitteområdet.
2. Gå til  > **System**.
3. Velg et rom med en lydplanke og velg **Legg til surroundhøytalere** for å komme i gang.

Merk: Hvis du i stedet oppretter en romgruppe eller et stereopar, får du ikke surroundlyd.

Surroundhøytalere

Slå surroundlyd **av** eller **på**.

Musikkavspilling

Omgivelser (myk) eller **Full** (sterkere lyd, hele registeret). Gjelder ikke for Dolby Atmos-musikkavspilling.

Skru av Wi-Fi

Du kan slå av høyttalerens Wi-Fi når den er tilkoblet nettverket med en Ethernet-kabel. Dette reduserer strømforbruket og kan gi bedre tilkoblingsmuligheter for noen kablede høyttalere.

EQ

Sonos-produktene leveres med forhåndsinnstilte utjevningsinnstillinger.

Batterisparing (bærbare produkter)

For å spare batteritid, kan du stille den bærbare høyttaleren til å slås av automatisk i stedet for å gå i dvale. Den vil ikke vises i Sonos-appen før den slås på igjen.

Line-in (produkter med line-in-funksjon)

Koble til en lydenhet, som en platespiller eller et stereoanlegg, til en Amp, Port eller Five. Gå til **Bla gjennom > Line-In** og velg kilden for å begynne avspilling. Du kan justere innstillinger for line-in, som kildenavn, lydnivå og autoplay.

Era 100 Stand

Custom designed stand for Sonos Era 100 holds speaker securely in place.

- Fixed height, optimal for home theater surrounds.
- Easy assembly.
- Channel in the pole hides the speaker's power cable for simple cable management.

What's in the box?

Each Sonos Era 100 Stand assembly includes:

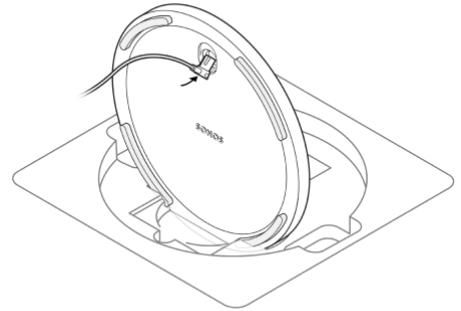

Set it up

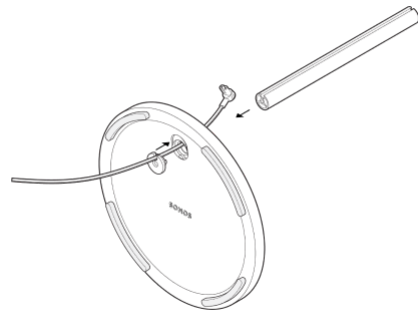
Take everything out of the box and place the base in the packaging slot to stabilize it for the next few steps. Thread the end of the Sonos Era 100 power cord that attaches to the speaker through the opening in the stand base and into the pole channel.

Caution: This stand is intended only for use with Sonos Era 100.



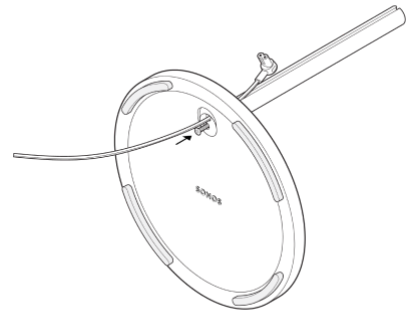

Position the washer with the alignment pins facing in. Then align the stand pole with the base, using the alignment pins to guide you.



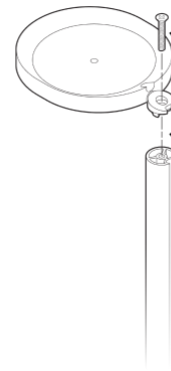

Fasten the base (with the washer) to the stand pole using 1 long screw (included) and a Phillips-head screwdriver. Make sure the cord can still slide freely.

Use the alignment pins to position the speaker platform on the pole, then attach the speaker platform to the stand pole using the other long screw (included).



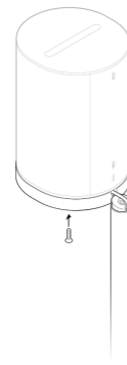

Bring the power cord up to the speaker and plug it in, then neatly press the power cord into the cable channel on the pole, working from top to bottom.



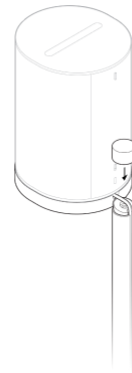

Attach the speaker to the platform using the short screw (included).



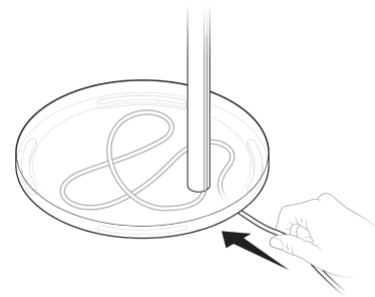

Snap the pole cap onto the top of the stand pole to hide the power cord.

Plug the speaker into a power outlet, then tuck the excess cord under the base.



Era 100 Wall Mount

- The easy-to-install mount for Sonos Era 100.
- Supports the weight of your speaker and secures it in place.
- Allows access to ports, buttons, and touch controls, and cleanly routes your speaker's cable.
- Flexibility to position your speaker for best sound.

Important: This mount is intended for use with Sonos Era 100 in a vertical orientation, as the acoustic and wireless performance of the speaker has been optimized for a standard table-top orientation.

What's in the box?

Each custom-designed Sonos Era 100 wall mount assembly includes:

- 1 wall mount
- 1 wall bracket
- 2 drywall anchors
- Mounting kit with 3 screws (2 long wall bracket screw, 1 short speaker mount screw)

Note: Sonos speakers sold separately.

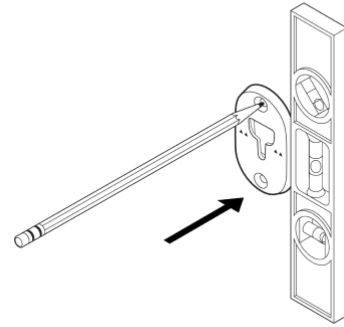
What you'll need

- Pencil
- Level
- Phillips-head screwdriver

Set it up

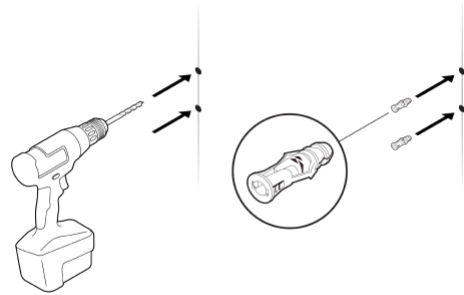
Place the bracket against the wall using a level to make sure it's aligned, and mark the screw holes. Remove the bracket.

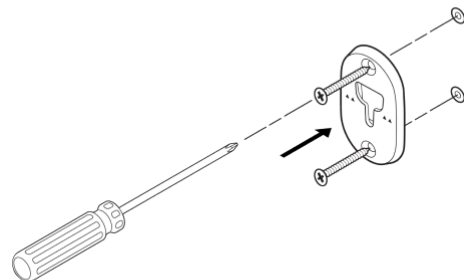
If you're using wall anchors, use a 5/16" drill bit to drill 2 pilot holes, starting with the hole on the top. Then insert the wall anchors. (Don't use wall anchors if you're drilling into wood or plastic.)

If you're not using wall anchors, locate a wall stud and drill the pilot holes with a 9/64" bit.



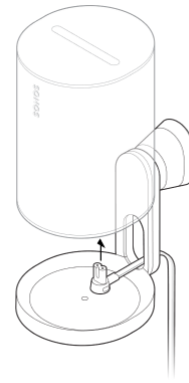

Place the bracket against the wall with the arrows facing up. Secure it using 2 long wall bracket screws (included) and a power drill or Phillips-head screwdriver. Drive the top screw in halfway. Drive the bottom one in all the way, then tighten the top screw.



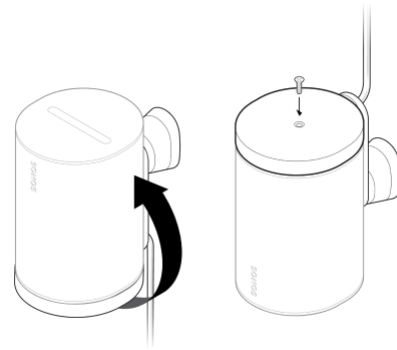

Thread the power cord through the opening at the back of the mount and plug it into the speaker.



5

Rotate the speaker 180 degrees so the screw hole is facing up. Attach the speaker to the mount using 1 short speaker mount screw (included).



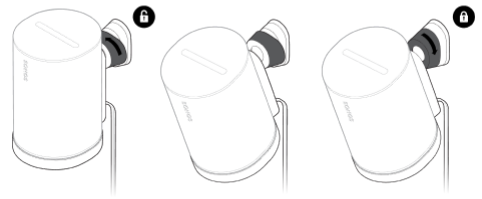

Align the mount with the bracket keyhole, slide the mount down, and lock it into place. Make sure the mount and speaker are securely seated before removing your hand.

To adjust for optimal sound, unlock the speaker by rotating the collar on the mount 90° counterclockwise. Reposition the speaker, then rotate the collar 90° clockwise to lock.
