## **FACTS**

1990 - 1992: Great States Insurance, Co. insured Danken for their workers compensation insurance. Because Danken's claims were so high for the 1991 year, Great States billed them for an additional premium for the year, Plaintiff eventually sued for payment of Workers. Compensation insurance additional premiums, Defendant cross-complained for Bad Faith handling of claims made by its employees.

Plaintitt claimed that all claims were handled aggressively and properly. Plaintiff's fraud unit had successfully disallowed substantial medical liens in favor of Canken. Therefore, the claims paid were not excessive and Dalendant owed the additional premium for the 1991 year as per their contract.
