

GOLDMINE

- During all Week 13 games in 2017, NFL players had the chance to share the causes that are important to them as part of the NFL's My Cause, My Cleats campaign. TAYLOR'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Taylor's father, Greg, played linebacker at Western Kentucky University from 1982-85 where he played under WKU's all-time wins leader, Jimmy Feix, for two seasons (1984-85).
- In 2016, Taylor led the nation with 1,803 rec. yds. on 136 recpts. to go along with 12 TDs.
- Taylor has lived in three states during his life, including Kentucky, Louisiana and Tennessee. During his time in Tennessee, he became very fond of the city of Nashville and country music.

- In April of 2018, Taylor and his teammates attended the eighth annual Prom at UCSF Benioff Children's Hospital San Francisco in Mission Bay, with more than 200 teen patients and their friends. Patients and 49ers players enjoyed a fun-filled "Vintage Circus" prom with photo booths, music, dancing, dining and more. This special evening allowed patients to participate in a milestone that they may miss as a result of sickness.



- Growing up, Taylor was a multi-sport athlete while attending Evangel Christian (Shreveport, LA) high school. He was an all-state baseball player in addition to participating in track and long jump. For one season, Taylor played tennis with his quarterback as his doubles partner and the two were state runners-up that year.
- While playing defensive back in high school, Taylor hit an opponent with such ferocity that he broke the receiver's jaw.

TAYLOR'S TRANSACTIONS

Originally the second of two 5th–round (177th overall) draft choices by SF in 2017.



2017

- Played in 15 games (1 start) and registered 43 receipts. for 430 yds. and 2 TDs, while adding 30 PRs for 281 yds. (9.4 avg.).
- Led all rookies and ranked t-6th in the NFL with 27 receipts. on 3rd down. Of his 27 3rd-down receipts., 66.7 pct. (18) converted a 1st down.
- Registered his 1st career TD on a 3-yd. pass from QB Brian Hoyer vs. LAR (9/21).
- Tallied a 39-yd. PR at Was. (10/15), the longest of his career. It marked the longest PR by the 49ers since 11/25/13 (RB LaMichael James - 40-yds.).
- Notched career-highs in both receipts. (6) and rec. yds. (92) at Chi. (12/3). At the time, his 92 rec. yds. were the most by a 49ers rookie since 12/8/96 (WR Terrell Owens - 110 rec. yds. vs. Car.).
- Hauled in a 5-yd. TD pass from QB Jimmy Garoppolo vs. Jax. (12/24). It marked his 2nd TD receipt. of his career (9/21/17 vs. LAR).

COLLEGE

In four seasons at Louisiana Tech, played in 53 games and registered 327 receipts. for 4,179 yds. and 32 TDs, while adding 58 PRs for 482 yds. Finished his collegiate career ranked 1st in school history with 327 career receipts. and 2nd in both rec. yds. (4,179) and TDs (32). In 2016, earned First-Team All-Conference USA honors as a WR and Second-Team All-Conference USA honors as PR. Also earned First-Team All-Louisiana honors from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association. Started all 14 games and notched 136 receipts. for 1,803 yds. and 12 TDs. Also added 17 PRs for 176 yds. His 1,803 rec. yds. ranked 1st in the NCAA and set a single-season school record. As a junior, earned First-Team All-Conference USA and First-Team All-Louisiana honors. Played in 13 games and tallied 99 receipts. for 1,282 yds. and 9 TDs while adding 13 PRs for 83 yds. In 2014, earned Second-Team All-Conference USA and Honorable Mention All-Louisiana honors. Played in 14 games and tallied 64 receipts. for 834 yds. and 9 TDs. Also had 22 PRs for 168 yds. As a freshman, played in 12 games and notched 28 receipts. for 260 yds. and 2 TDs, while adding 6 PRs for 53 yds.

- Attended Evangel Christian Academy (Shreveport, LA), and earned all-state, all-district and all-city honors and was named MVP of the state championship game as a senior.
- Registered 107 receipts. for 1,650 yds. and 20 TDs as a senior.
