DARRELL WILLIAMS JR.

GOLDMINE

- Williams earned the nickname "Diesel" during his time playing basketball in middle school. His diesel-like work ethic on the basketball court then carried over to the football field where he earned a scholarship to Western Kentucky University to play under head coach Jeff Brohm. "He really battles out there," said Brohm. "He was a great leader for our offense and I loved having him on our team." Williams is a versatile O-Lineman who has knowledge of the entire offensive line. He has seen action at both right and left tackle. Former Western Kentucky teammate and current Los Angeles Chargers guard Forrest Lamp spoke highly of Williams. "They say in the NFL that when you're able to play every single position, that's when you're really, really able to help the team," said Lamp. "It diversifies his mindset. He's always been able to do it."

COLLEGE

Appeared in 46 games during his five years (2012-16) at Western Kentucky. Started 38 consecutive games over his final 3 seasons along the offensive line for the Hilltoppers. As a senior in 2016, was part of an offensive line that paved the way for a 7th-consecutive 1,000-yd. rusher. In 2015, started all 14 games at RT, anchoring the right side of an offensive line that finished the year ranked 19th nationally in sacks allowed, with just 16 sacks on 554 pass atts., the 7th-best percentage nationally and 2nd among teams with 500-or-more atts. During the 2014 season, he started 10 straight games at right guard, helping pave the way for 2,018 all-purpose yds. from RB Leon Allen. Saw action in 7 games in 2013, starting the final three at right tackle. Redshirted in 2012.
