ANDRE HOLMES is in his second year in Buffalo and his 7th in the NFL after signing a three-year contract with the Bills in 2017. Holmes provides size and depth at the wide receiver position and on special teams. He entered the NFL as undrafted free agent with the Vikings from Division II Hillsdale College. After stints with Minnesota, Dallas and New England early in his career, Holmes finally made his mark in Oakland, playing four seasons with the Raiders (2013-16).

UNLIKELY ROUTE

Holmes is an example of perserverance. He did not play much football in high school. Division II Hillsdale was the only school to offer him a scholarship. In the NFLPA Bowl game in 2011, he "didn't know how to get off press coverage and got destroyed. Going against Division I athletes was a new experience." It all worked out well.

It is no accident Holmes is one of the most producive speical teamers on the team. "I take a lot of pride on playing special teams. That's how I got on the field early in my career. A special teams play starts every series. It sets the tone."

Holmes (pictured above with other inductees in the Hillsdale College Hall of Fame) started playing football as a 170 pounder in high school. "I have always felt I was behind the curve in sports growing up. Whether I was too slow, too skinny, or played at a small college, I always felt I had something to prove. And the fear of failure always motivated me."

He heeded the advice from his college offensive coordinator Barry Fagan. "There was a moment after my redshirt freshman year, where I had to fill out a form listing goals. I left the part about long-term goals empty and my coach said if I stay committed to the weight room and the classroom, anything is possible. And he was always on me. He was on me every part of practice. He worked me hard."

TURNING POINT

Barely played on his high school varsity team until his senior. In fact, he thought about giving up football altogether and play soccer. He continued to play as a senior and after a 0-4 start, he became very frustrated again playing wide receiver in an offense that was geared toward running.
