

## SHOUTOUTS

- Since joining the Bills in 2013, Hughes leads all Buffalo pass rushers with 35 sacks.
- Hughes started his Bills career on a tear, piling up back-to-back double digit sacks seasons in 2013 and 2014. Hughes is one of just four pass rushers in franchise history to record consecutive double digit sack seasons, joining: Bruce Smith (1986-1990, 1992-1998), Aaron Schobel (2005-2006) and Mario Williams (2012-2014).
- Hughes tied with DE Shaq Lawson for the Bills 2018 sack lead with four. Hughes also ranked second on the Bills with 11 QB hits, trailing LB Lorenzo Alexander (15).
- Hughes ranked second on the Bills in sacks in 2016 after racking up six quarterback takedowns.
- Hughes showed that his abilities aren't limited to the football field in 2017, as he won LeSean McCoy's Shades of Greatness home run derby fundraiser. Hughes hit five dingers in the final round to be named champion.



BILLS

JERRY HUGHES is entering his sixth season with the Bills in 2018. Acquired via trade by the Bills from the Indianapolis Colts in 2013, Hughes originally entered the NFL as a first round draft choice

(31st overall) of the Colts out of TCU. A dynamic pass rusher, Hughes has registered a teamhigh 35 sacks since 2013.

A native of the Houston-area. Hughes stepped up in a big way following Hurrican Harvey in 2017.

Via his Instagram, Hughes announced: Fellow Houstonians and Bills Mafia: What is happening in my home city of Houston is completely devastating and heart wrenching. Watching this crisis from so far away I feel helpless and I want to do whatever I can to help the victims impacted by this tragedy. I will be donating \$50,000

to Mayor Sylvester Turners Hurricane Harvey Relief Fund. Additionally I will give \$5,000 for each sack I record. I hope and pray my teammates, friends, and fans will join me in making a donation as well. Thank you all for your support!

By season's end, Hughes donated a grand total of \$70,000 to the recovery efforts.
