- In his first season with the Bills, Yarbrough appeared in all 16 games, starting six. He recorded 34 tackles and one sack.
- Earned a season high five tackles in the Bills post-season game versus Jacksonville.
- Recorded his first career sack against the Carolina Panthers during Week 2, taking down quarterback Cam Newton.
- Yarbrough was named a First-Team All-Mountain West selection during his tenure at Wyoming three times in voting by conference head coaches and media.
- Wyoming's all-time leader in tackles for loss with 39, and carved out 256 total career tackles for the Cowboys.
- Father, Eddie Yarbrough Sr, played football at Arkansas Pine Bluff.

Yarbrough has a passion for helping others and helped start a Special Olympics Unified Sports program at Grandview High School during his time as a student there. He worked with Grandview's principal at the time, Kurt Wollenweber, to promote inclusion through the sport.

The program brings students with and without intellectual disabilities together to play on the same team. Grandview's Unified Sports program has gained national attention through the Unified Hoops team, which is the largest and most diverse Unified team in the country with more than 60 people involved, both special needs and able-bodied. Yarbrough says one of his favorite memories is cheering for them.

Eddie participated in the My Cause, My Cleats initiative this past season, representing and shedding light on the foundation he cares so much about.
