



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What kind of surface is the race on?

- a. Participants will be running/walking on both a grass and concrete surface.

2. Will there be a race guide?

- a. Yes. There will be a police officer directing all participants as well as course marshals throughout the race route.

3. How far is a 5K?

- a. 5 Kilometers = 3.1 miles

4. How far is the Fun Run?

- a. The Fun Run is approximately a 1-mile course. It is not chipped or timed.

5. How much is parking?

- a. Parking is \$25 and is good for both the race and the game. You can enter through the Himes Ave gate or the Martin Luther King Blvd entrance gate. Please note that Himes Avenue will close at 6:30AM so if arriving after that time you will need to enter off of the MLK Blvd entrance. We anticipate over 3,500 racers arriving at the same time, so we recommend making sure you are at One Buc Place no later than 6:45am to ensure time to park and get to the starting line.

6. What time does the race start?

- a. The race will begin at 7:30am sharp and will be in 5 different waves, 3 minutes apart. Waves will be based off expected mile time/bib number. Your bib will be color coded based on what race wave you are in.

7. Will I be able to run/walk with a stroller?

- a. Yes

8. How long will I have to run/walk the race?

- a. Due to parking lots opening at 9:30AM for the Browns vs. Buccaneers game, all racers must be off the course no later than 9:00AM. If you think it will take you more than 20 minutes per mile to complete the course, it is recommended that you register for the Fun Run.

9. How is my time recorded?

- a. The 5K race is chip-timed and participants will receive a bib with a timing chip attached to it. The chip will begin timing once you cross the start line, recording your net time until you cross the finish line. The Fun Run is a non-competitive race and will not be chip-timed.

10. Will water or food be provided before or after the race?

- a. There will be water stations throughout the course and a post-race refreshment area in "Victory Village" along with partner activations, awards, and live music.

11. Where can I use the restrooms?

- a. On-site portable restrooms will be available

12. Is there a bag-drop?

- a. There is no bag drop off. Please leave all of your belongings locked safely in your car. If you are picking up your packet the morning of the race, please remember you will need a photo ID and will also receive your game ticket (if applicable) so allow yourself time to pick up your packet and return to your car if you do not wish to carry those items with you during the race.

13. Are there water stops along the race course?

- a. Yes, we will have one water stop along the course at mile 1.5 and at the finish. Post-race water will also be available at the hospitality/awards tent in Victory Village.

14. Where will results be posted?

- a. Results will be posted on the video boards of Raymond James Stadium immediately following the race.

Official results will be posted on www.buccaneers.com later in the day.

15. Who is the race benefiting?

- a. A portion of the proceeds from the 6th Annual Tampa Bay Buccaneers Treasure Chests 5K Fun Run powered by Jabil will benefit breast cancer research and patient services at Florida Hospital, Moffitt Cancer Center, Florida Cancer Specialists Foundation, and the American Cancer Society.

16. What time is the awards ceremony

- a. The awards ceremony is scheduled for approximately 8:45am on the stage located in Victory Village.

PACKET PICKUP

1. When is packet pick-up?

- a. Packet pick-up will take place on Thursday October 18th from 4:00PM-8:00PM and Friday October 19th from 11:00AM-7:00PM. Packet Pick-up will take place at the Buccaneers Team Store located on the west side of the stadium.

2. Will I be able to pick-up my packet the day of the race?

- a. Yes. Packet pick-up will be available from 6:00AM-7:00AM in Lot 14 near the starting line, however it is highly recommended to pick up in advance as lines will be long on race day. If you arrive after 7am we will still hand out packets however we cannot guarantee you will receive prior to the 7:30am race start.

3. What do I need to bring to packet pick-up?

- a. A driver's license or form of ID is required to pick up packets.
- b. A signed waiver (these will be completed online during registration if you are registering for yourself. If you register anyone else, they will need to go in and sign their own waiver using the confirmation email they will receive.

4. Can someone else pick-up my packet for me?

- a. Yes. If someone else picks up your packet they will need to bring the attached form saying that you allow them to pick up your packet as well as ensure you have signed your online waiver. If you plan to pick up for others, you will need to bring a signed copy of the form below for each person you are picking up for as well as make sure each participant has signed their online waiver.

5. How do I know if a waiver is signed?

- a. The person who was the primary purchaser is required to sign an online waiver during registration. If you signed up multiple people or someone signed you up, each participant will need to go into their race registration and sign their own waiver. We will not be able to release a packet without a signed waiver and packet pickup authorization so please make sure these are done before arriving at packet pick-up. Instructions on how to sign the waiver will be in each persons' confirmation email. If you are the primary purchaser and used your email for all participants you registered, you will need to make sure to forward the confirmation to the other participants, so they can sign their waivers.

6. How will game tickets be assigned?

- a. Game tickets (if applicable) will be handed out at packet pick-up. If you would like to sit next to other participants, you will need to all pick up your packets at the same time. If packets are picked up at different times, you WILL NOT be seated next to each other as tickets are being handed out as packets are picked up. If you are registering as a Season Pass Member (must be a current member with a valid SPM account ID) registration does not include a game ticket.

5. I live out of state will you be able to ship my packet?

- a. Unfortunately, we do not provide this service. Race Day packet pickup will be available from 6:00AM-7:00AM the morning of the race.

HALFTIME (IF APPLICABLE)

1. How will I know if I'm one of the first 500 runners to sign-up?

- a. You will receive a confirmation email confirming that you are one of the first 500 runners. Please save the email confirmation stating that you are part of the first 500 participants to register for the race. If selected to be the first 500, you will receive additional information via email.

2. What does the halftime experience include?

- a. Treasure Chest 5K + Fun Run participants will have the opportunity to take the field during the Breast Cancer Awareness game and raise your flags in support of those affected in our Tampa Bay community during the halftime performance.
