

PRE-GAME TAILGATING

One of the great traditions in the National Football League is enjoying time together with family, friends and other Cardinals fans before each home game. Tailgating in Sportsman's Park or Team controlled parking areas where permitted is intended for game day ticket members only. Preparing a pre-game meal, sharing stories from past games and taking in the excitement on the Great Lawn are some of the accepted tailgating practices prior to a Cardinals game. Excessive consumption of alcohol, playing music at a disruptive volume and use of charcoal grills are some examples of actions not allowed. Tailgating after the game has begun or post-game is not permitted. All fans are reminded the Arizona Cardinals Code of Conduct extends throughout Sportsman's Park and all game day parking areas.

2017 GAME DAY PARKING GUIDELINES

- Sportsman's Park carparks and other vehicle parking areas open four (4) hours prior to kickoff to both vehicles and guests. Please follow the direction of law enforcement as vehicles cannot stage on or block the flow of traffic on city streets prior to the opening of carparks and lots. Carpark access available until 90 minutes after kickoff. If arriving later, please call (623) 433-7156 for additional assistance. Vehicles are not allowed to park overnight prior to game day.
- Sportsman's Park and other Cardinals parking areas close one (1) hour after the conclusion of the game. Tailgating activities are allowed from the opening of Sportsman's Park and until kickoff only.
- A parking hangtag is valid for one (1) parking space only. No trailers of any kind are permitted inside any parking area. Vehicles taking more than one parking space or parked incorrectly will be subject to tow. All fees associated with the removal and impounding of the vehicle will be the responsibility of the owner.
- Oversized vehicles - The only oversized parking area, Lot F, opens 4 hours and 30 minutes prior to kickoff. Each oversized vehicle must have a valid "Lot F Oversized Vehicle" hangtag for access. Oversize vehicles may not escort or accompany any additional vehicles into Lot F (one vehicle per hangtag.) Maximum parking space length in Lot F Oversized is 45 feet (including any trailers).
- "Speed loading of the parking lots" - Fans are asked to follow the direction of the parking team member to quickly park your vehicle. Vehicles that do not park in a location instructed by parking team member are subject to tow and loss of their hangtag for the remainder of the season.
- Fans that wish to park next to friends must arrive at the same time. Parking spots cannot be reserved or saved for fans arriving at a later time.
- Tailgating in the parking lots must be limited to the area directly in front of or behind the vehicle. **Tailgating in empty stalls is prohibited, even with an unused hangtag.** Tailgating equipment, such as chairs, tents, propane/natural gas grills and other items, cannot extend beyond the painted fire lanes for vehicles or sidewalks.
- Excessive or underage consumption of alcohol will not be tolerated. Drinking games or any other activity that is linked to competitive or binge drinking is not permitted. Games or activities determined by security which could cause harm to other fans will not be allowed.
- Natural gas or propane grills are permitted in Sportsman's Park and other Cardinals parking areas. For the safety of all fans, **charcoal grills and oil fryers are not permitted.**
- Glass containers are not permitted at Sportsman's Park or any Cardinals parking area.
- Fans are permitted to bring up to a 10' by 10' shade tent to be used on the grass areas within Sportsman's Park. So that many fans can enjoy the Great Lawn and south fields, tailgate groups will be limited to one tent. **Tents and tailgating equipment used in the parking areas must not extend beyond the red painted fire lanes, along sidewalks and painted walkways or other areas deemed by stadium staff as an obstruction.**
- Fans are not allowed to rope off or reserve large tailgate areas in the parking areas or on the Great Lawn.
- Fans are limited to preparing food for their family and friends. Private catering companies are not allowed in the Sportsman's Park and other Cardinals parking areas. The sale of food or beverage items to other fans is also not permitted.
- Golf carts, Segways, skateboards, bicycles, scooters, hover boards and other non-licensed motorized vehicles are not permitted to be operated within Sportsman's Park or other Cardinals parking areas.
- Radio controlled model aircraft, unmanned aircraft systems and other similar devices (i.e. drones) are prohibited at University of Phoenix Stadium and within all game day parking areas. Possession or operation of such devices will result in immediate ejection from the area and potential law enforcement intervention.
- Portable Public Address systems are not permitted at Sportsman's Park or other Cardinals parking areas. Large portable radios and sound systems inside vehicles cannot be used at excessive volume levels or playing music not suitable for a public setting (i.e. profanity in lyrics) as determined by parking lot or security team member.
- Small portable electric generators (6500W or less) are allowed. However, electrical cords cannot be placed across parking area drive aisles, any sidewalk including the Great Lawn or create a trip hazard for guests.
- Advertising of goods or services is not permitted at Sportsman's Park or other Cardinals parking areas. Vehicles with exterior advertising can be stopped from entering even with a valid hangtag. Hanging commercial signage on vehicles, tents or by other means is also not permitted.
- Sportsman's Park and other Cardinals parking areas are patrolled by parking lot and security team members and local law enforcement officers. Tampering or removing of any parking lot infrastructure is strictly prohibited. The Arizona Cardinals Code of Conduct will be enforced throughout all parking areas. Along with season tickets, parking hangtags can and will be revoked for non-compliance of Cardinals parking regulations and/or Code of Conduct.
