

FREE FOOTBALL CLEATS



Football cleats in large sizes can be both difficult to find and expensive. The New England Patriots Charitable Foundation provides new or gently used football cleats to youth and high school students athletes throughout New England. Requests will be considered for student athletes from low and moderate income families.

Who Can Request

High School Athletic Directors, Head Football Coaches, Youth Football League Presidents and Youth Football Coaches may request cleats for players in need in their respective programs. Requests will also be accepted from individual student athletes. Football cleats must be picked up from Gillette Stadium by the coach or student athlete at a mutually agreed upon date and time. A waiver must be signed by the parent or guardian of each student athlete receiving a pair of cleats. One pair per athlete only.

Available sizes

New and gently used football cleats are available in sizes 13 -18. An extremely limited selection of gently used cleats may be available in sizes 11 and 12.

RELEASE & INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

By using athletic cleats (the "Cleats") provided to the undersigned, either directly or indirectly, by The New England Patriots Charitable Foundation, Inc., the participant named below (and his or her parent or legal guardian on his or her behalf) hereby releases and forever discharges The New England Patriots Charitable Foundation, Inc., the New England Patriots L.P., and their respective officers, members, owners, employees, agents, representatives and affiliated persons and entities (collectively, the "Released Persons") from any and all liabilities and claims of any kind (including personal injury, property damage or death), which the participant or his or her legal representatives, has or may in the future have, whether known or unknown, arising out of, or relating in any way to, that participant's acceptance, use or ownership of the Cleats (collectively, the "Released Claims").

This Release is binding even if the risks and liabilities being released arise out of the negligence or carelessness of one or more of the Released Persons. This Release is binding on the participant's legal representatives, heirs and assigns. The invalidity or enforceability of any part of this Release shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of any of the remainder of this Release.

The person signing this Release acknowledges the possibility that the participant or his or her legal representatives may not fully know the number or magnitude of all the Released Claims, but nevertheless intends to **assume the risk** of the participant using the Cleats and is releasing those unknown claims. The person signing this Release further agrees that they will use the Cleats himself/herself and will not provide use of the Cleats to any third party.

If a participant is under 18 years old, this Release must be signed by the participant's parent or legal guardian.*
