DES Report - Wade Pelham

The legislative breakfast was last Thursday. Larry was there and spoke at length with Senator Denise Ricciardi. There was a full crowd and the even was successful.

For legislative activity regarding House Bill 1275 which was proposing a 5 year moratorium on bio solids applied to agricultural lands to the state of NH which can create a capacity issue with the waste water plants. The legislation was amended and the moratorium part was removed and continued testing of biosolids was ordered along with a soil standard in the future. Testing ob biosolids is already currently happening so this will continue. A modeling effort is already in the works to come up with a soil standard. Wade believes this amendment was passed this afternoon on 3/11/26.
