DES report, Wade: He spoke about that DES was underway compiling a report of total grease operations for a step by step guide, including a financial review that can be presented to other wastewater treatment plants who may be interested in accepting grease in their future as a good revenue stream.

Member \$120: (Voting) Must be actively engaged in pumping and transporting contents of subsurface disposal systems that are permitted under the ENV-WQ 1600s, including portable toilet only companies.

Associate Member \$95: (Non - Voting) – Defined as any person, firm, or corporation who is associated with the evaluating, manufacture, installation, construction, or design of subsurface disposal systems, or who is engaged in an occupation or profession related to the inspection or regulation of such systems....upon approval of the Board of Directors and after payment of your annual dues.
