

HIGHLIGHTS

The itinerary is for all those who love to trek on high altitude glacial lake, we are giving opportunity of trekking the Bhirgu lake, the lake which offers high altitude glacial lake. Bhigru lake is easily accessible trek route in the upper Kullu valley. The trail goes through Virgin forests, snow capped mountains, tranquility of nature, bird eye views of the surrounding valley like Kullu Solang and Rohtang are trekkers delight. Then name of lake is derived from the peak called Bhigru. Also the legend Maharishi Bhirgu of saptarishi fame had mediated on the bank of the river. The lake remain frozen half of the year even in summer the approach is filled with the fun of walking on snow. It is a complete surprise package for traveler as you can find here a neatly carved wooden temple, hot spring, village home-stay, waterfall surrounding make it a complete destination for hikers.

Region – Himachal Altitude – 14,000 feet

Trekking Distance – 29 kms approx Accommodation – Tents/ Camp

Trip Start from – Manali Trip Ends in – Manali

Weather Report – In Summer, 20 to 24 degree during day and 5 to 10 degree during night

In winters, 10 to 15 degree during day and 0 to 7 degrees during night

ITINERARY DETAILS

Day 01

Manali to Gulaba

Altitude – 8,530 ft. Travel distance – 22km Travel Time- 1 hour

- •Report at Manali Govt. Bus Stand between 2:00 AM to 2:30 AM.
- •Meet our representative and board your bus to Gulaba 22 km away from Manali.
- •The journey from Manali to Gulaba is quite scenic on the same road to Rohtang Pass with breathtaking views of snow clad mountains tranquility of nature.
- •The drive is smooth but with a lot of sharp turns making the journey more thrilling.
- •Upon arrival, you will be transferred Meadows camp which is 2 km away from Gulaba so your trekking start from here only
- •Relax for some time.
- •Then there will be an introduction session of trekking team and briefing about tomorrow trekking.
- •Overnight stay in Camp.

Day 02

Gulaba to Rola Khuli

Altitude – 8,530 ft to 12,566 ft Tracking distance – 5 km Time taken – 3-4 hours

Water Sources:- Carry 2 litres of water from Gulaba. You can also refill your bottles at water source which is 15 minutes before Rola Khuli campsite and the second one is 10 minutes before – both at stream crossings.

- •Wake up early morning have your breakfast and leave the camp earlier.
- Start your trekking earlier.
- •While trekking don't forget to observe the most prominent trees in the Himalayas like silver oak, cedar and birch trees just away from 20 min. walk.
- •Also Mt. Hanuman Tibba towering over the meadow in the background.
- •Ahead, there's a milky white rivulet flowing down the imposing Kolang Valley. This is Kolang Nallah.
- •Walk straight towards it until you are walking along the banks of the stream. You have to cross over to the other side of the nallah.
- •Look for a **wooden makeshift bridge** to cross over. The bridge is usually washed away during monsoon.
- As you climb up enjoy brilliant views of Manali and Solang Valley.
- •Overnight stay in camp.

Day 03

Rola Khuli to Bhrigu Lake and back to Rola Khuli

Altitude - 12,565 ft to 14,009 ft; back to 12,565 ft
Tracking distance - 10 km
Time taken - 6-7 Hours approx
Difficulty level - Moderate lake

Water sources - Bhrigu lake, streams along the way so need

- •Wake up early morning as you have a lot distance to cover.
- •During trek it is possible that you can find trail covered in snow.
- •As you reach the ridge, look for an oval glacial lake in the distance.
- •Depending on the season, the lake is either surrounded by snow or fresh grass, along with alpine flowers.
- •In a clear day, you can catch a stunning panoramic view of Pir Pinjal and Dhauladhar ranges.,
- •Major peaks such as Indrasen, Deo Tibba and Hanuman Tibba stand majestically before you.
- •The lake is normally enveloped in fog which can make finding the route tricky. It is always advisable to hire a local guide.
- •After spending leisure time at the lake and retrace your way to Rola Khuli.
- Overnight stay in camp at Rola Khuli.

Day 04

Rola Khuli to Gulaba and Manali

Altitude – 12,565 ft to 6,791 ft Tracking distance – 5km Time taken – 3-4 hours approx Trek gradient –Easy

Water sources - Carry 2 liters of water from camp only

- •Wake up Early morning try to do some Yoga or take a walk.
- •Today trek is an easy one.
- •From meadows Camp you get back to Gulaba.
- •Upon arrival, Board another bus and reach to Manali which is 22 Km away from Gulaba
- Trip and services ends in Manali only.

PACKAGE INCLUSIONS:

- Accommodation. (Guest house, Home stay, Camping).
- Meals while on trek (Veg.).
- •Trek equipment's (Sleeping bag, mattress, Kitchen & dinning tent, crampon, utensils, tent).
- All necessary permits and entry fees.

- •First aid medical kits, stretcher and oxygen cylinder.
- Mountaineering qualified & professional trek Leader, guide and Support staff.
- •Transport from Kathgodam to Loharjung and return.

PACKAGE EXCLUSIONS:

- •Government service tax 9.0%.
- •Air/Train fare.
- •Anything not mentioned under the head inclusions.
- •The tariff does not include barbeque, personal expenses like telephone, laundry etc.
