ITINERARY DETAILS

DAY 01

Rishikesh - Uttarkashi (5h 7min / 170.7 km)

Morning, a warm welcome to the place, a hippie abode, the place where the Beatles took to spiritually under Mahesh Yogi, it is the Ganga that defines Rishikesh. Where Nirvana trip representative will meet you and will handover you Royal Enfield 350CC. What are you waiting for now. Start your bikes and ride towards the Uttarkashi, after hours of uphill roads, you find yourself descending into the breathtaking vista of the valley- the mountains with their forests of oak pine, green squares of cultivation and then the pounding Bhagirathi. Upon arrival at Uttarkashi check-in to pre-booked hotel and rest for a while in evening explore the local places the like Vishwanath Temple, next to the main market is considered by some to be as important as the one at Varanasi. Facing it is the Shakti Temple, with its splendid iron and copper trident. There were once 365 temples here —the ones dedicated to Annapurna Devi, Kali are still signifiant. Dinner and Overnight stay at hotel.

Uttarkashi – Nelong Valley (4h 19min/116.5km) – Uttarkashi

Morning treat your taste bud with super delicious food head towards Nelong Valley. First you have to reach the Government office where you need to complete the formality and hope up into the Government jeep and head towards the Nelong valley **Nelong**Valley It's an another thrilling adventure on mountains of Uttarkashi in Uttarakhand. Administration of Uttarkashi found a new unique way at the altitude of 11000 feet which is situated in Jaal Ganga Valley at the border of India & China. Half kms long Garthang Gali was one of the main routes of business of India & Tibet in 1962. This path was founded by the Pathan's of Pesawer (in Pakistan) in 17 century. If we have a look on history we will see that in ancient time this valley was a path of business with Tibet via Uttarkashi. The Administration says this was the path of business in ancient time of Badhat or Tibet and Ganga Valley. In their Garthang Gali's name is in history. At the time of war between India & China in 1962 Government of India moved the 04 Bhutia community villages Nelong & Jahan villages & prohibited the place. Now this Garthang Gali is open for all the visitors and valley will be more adventures & thrilling as you are walking on 11000 Feet (3666 Mts) on the small path. You can see ice capped mountains of Tibet. Once you are done with the Nelong Valley return back and to Uttarkashi for dinner and overnight stay.

DAY 03

Uttarkashi to Gangotri (2h 54min/99.7km)- Gomukh Glacier trek

In the morning view the sun rise on high hills with a cup of tea. Later after breakfast drive towards Gangotri via a beautiful valley of Harsil (approx 25 km before Gangotri (3048 mt) by covering approx 95 km in 4-5 hrs.

Gangotri: The shrine of Gangotri is situated at an elevation of 3200 m surrounded by deodars and pines. The original temple was constructed by the Gorkha General Amar Singh Thapa. Every year people from all around the world visit this shrine. A number of ashrams and Dharamshalas are located on the other side of the river. It is believed that Raja Bhagirath used to worship Shiva on a slab of rock "Bhagirath Shila" situated near the temple. Submerged in the river there is a natural Shivling where, according to mythology, Lord Shiva sat when he received the Goddess Ganga in his matted locks. A days trek takes one to Gomukh, the source of the mighty Ganges. Upon arrival check in to hotel head towards the Gomukh glacier is the source of Bhagirathi (Ganges) and is held in high esteem by the devout that do not miss the opportunity to have a holy dip in the bone chilling icy water. Trek to Gomukh (3890mt), the source of the Ganges. Gomukh is where the water of Ganga trickles down from the glaciers. The sages called it 'Gomukh', because in the distant past, it probably appeared like a cow's mouth. Upon arrival pitch your camp and enjoy the magnificent view. Our travel guide who will going with you on trek will help you in knowing more about the place. Dinner and Overnight stay at camp.

Gomukh Glacier trek – Gangotri- Uttarkashi

Morning after breakfast trek back of 14 km with the same route upon arrival if your energy permits you, you can explore the temple at Gangotri, believed to have been consecrated by Adi Shankaracharya was built by General Amar Singh Thapa of the Nepalese forces sometime in the 18th century. The Maharaja of Jaipur, Madho Singh, renovated the temple in 1935. Near the temple is Bhagirath Shila a stone slab where king Bhagirath meditated. After which you need to head towards the Uttarkashi. Upon arrival at uttarkashi, checkin to hotel and relax yourself. In evening if your energy permits you explore the local market or simply rest. Dinner and Overnight stay at Hotel.

DAY

05

Uttarkashi – Rishikesh(5h 7min / 170.7 km)

Morning after the super delicious breakfast, check-out from hotel and drive towards the Rishikesh. Where you have to return back the bikes. Trip and service ends at Rishikesh
