The relatively small country of Nepal hosts 8 out of 10 of the world's highest mountain peaks and is also home to many endangered animal species.

Start your journey with Kathmandu to discover its medieval old streets and architecture, the rich wildlife of Chitwan. Relax and admire the stunning panorama of the snow-capped mountain ranges in Pokhara.

- Explore the medieval streets of Bhaktapur Square.
- Visit Boudhanath Stupa, the largest stupa in Nepal.
- Witness the Hindu rituals at Pashupatinath Temple.
- Explore the rich wildlife of Chitwan.
- Soak in the scenic beauty of Pokhara.



## ITINERARY DETAILS

### DAY 01 Arrive Kathmandu

On your arrival at Kathmandu Airport, you will be greeted by our representative in the arrival hall, who will escort you to your hotel and assist you in check-in.

Later, proceed for a sightseeing tour of Kathmandu. Kathmandu is a captivating city to be discovered. Today the city is slowly rebuilding after the earthquake and most of the tourist attractions have reopened making the city a must visit again while traveling in Nepal.

This city combines the best of the country: from old-world streets, rich art and architecture dating back to centuries, to the finest temples and delicate handicrafts, the hustle and bustle of its colorful markets and the popular Nepali food.

Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 02****Kathmandu**

After morning breakfast, a sightseeing tour of Bhaktapur Durbar Square to explore its medieval streets and its traditional Nepali architecture with intricate wood carvings. Stroll down South Bhaktapur Square to reach the Pottery Square, where you can admire the beautiful handicrafts.

Later, visit Bouddhanath Stupa – the largest stupa in Nepal, rich in Buddhist symbolism. Pilgrims come here to light butter lamps, chant mantras, and spin prayer wheels. Take a stroll around the dome and soak in the wonderful atmosphere.

Later drive to Pashupatinath Temple – the most important Hindu Temple in Nepal situated on the banks of River Bagmati. Time your arrival with the evening prayer ceremony by the river and perhaps even get an opportunity to talk to one of the Sadhus or priests and learn about the tenants of Hinduism.

Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 03****Kathmandu – Chitwan**

Wake up early, and after morning breakfast, we drive to Kurintar and take the cable car ride to visit Manakamana Temple. Cable car rises more than 1000metres above and offers magnificent views of Trishuli River and of the surrounding village.

Once you reach on top, the next part of the journey is a short hike which takes you to the Manakamana Temple, Manakamana means "wishes come true". It is believed that the Goddess Manakamana answers prayers of those who make the pilgrimage to worship her.

Descend the hike and the cable car journey to Kurintar. From Kurintar, drive to Chitwan is only 45 km ( One hour) and check-in.

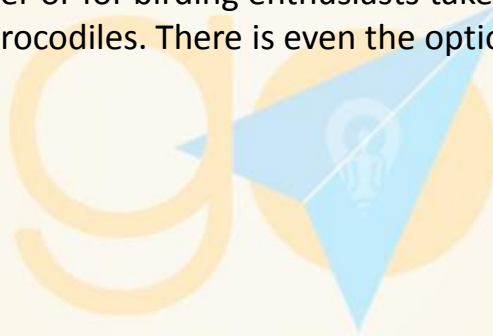
Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 04****Chitwan**

Spend your entire day exploring the wildlife of Chitwan. Chitwan National Park means "Heart of the Jungle". It is famous as one of Asia's richest and most diverse National Parks. You can spot one-horned rhinos, crocodiles, deer, elephants, monkeys, and pythons.

If you are very lucky you will get a chance to see the majestic Royal Bengal Tiger. Chitwan also has a wide variety of birds with approximately 500 species recorded. There are plenty of activities to choose from in between the park visits: visit the elephant breeding center or for birding enthusiasts take a jungle walk and spot different species of birds, or take a canoe ride to see the crocodiles. There is even the option of a village walk to meet the indigenous local people.

Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 05****Chitwan – Pokhara**

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara which is 87 km ( Two hours) from Chitwan. En route stop at Bandipur, situated on a ridge above the town of Dumre. Bandipur is a beautiful small village showcasing the old Newari culture. Due to its elevation at 1030 meters, Bandipur offers spectacular views of the Himalayas and Marshyangdi Valley.

Take a stroll through this living museum and admire the impressive architecture, beautiful caves, and unspoiled landscapes. Continue your drive to Pokhara. Pokhara is nature's gem and is one of the most spectacular locations in Nepal. Pokhara's appeal is enhanced by its amazing mountainous surroundings and the charming Phewa Lake.

On arrival check-in and the remainder of the day is at leisure. Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 06****Pokhara**

After morning breakfast set out for a 2 hours gentle hike to Kalabang Village. Kalabang village is situated on a hilltop at 1500 metres above sea level. The village is worth the hike and offers a stunning panorama of the snow-capped mountain ranges, lush vegetation, shimmering water of Phewa Lake and the beautiful Pokhara valley.

After a cup of refreshing tea, visit the local village and interact with the locals. Visit the community school, if it is open.

Later drive back to Pokhara. The afternoon is at leisure for some independent explorations. You can do few activities like fishing, paragliding, or simply walk around leisurely, admiring the mountain peaks mirrored in the calm waters of Phewa Lake. Capture this picturesque panorama for some great photography.

Overnight, stay at the hotel.

**DAY 07****Pokhara – Kathmandu**

Wake up early morning to watch the sunrise from Sarangkot and capture the changing colors of the Himalayan peaks. It is a spellbindingly timeless moment.

After breakfast, check out from the hotel to fly back to Kathmandu. Upon arrival in Kathmandu, transfer to hotel.

In the evening, take a one-hour rickshaw ride through the bustling and colorful bazaars of Kathmandu to reach Thamel. Feel the vibrant pulse of Thamel. Explore the shops, bars, and restaurants of this beautiful area. There are plenty of dining options available here and you can try some of the local cuisines on the last evening of your Nepal holiday.

Overnight, stay at the hotel.

Today your tour in Nepal, the heart of the Himalayas comes to an end.

Our representative will assist you with a smooth check-out from the hotel and escort you to the airport.

We arrange your drop to the Kathmandu Airport, from where you will board your flight back home. We advise you to arrive at the airport at least 3 hours prior to departure and keep your passport and a printout of airline ticket handy to avoid last minute hassles.
