Munnar got its name from its location at the confluence of three rivers – Muthirapuzha, Nallathanni and Kundala Rivers. 'Moonu' means 'three' and 'Aru' means 'river'. Once the summer capital of the British in South India, this region is at a height of 1,500 m to 2,695 m above sea level.

Tea Museum

The Tea Museum is located at the Nallathanni Estate of Tata Tea. Tea Museum houses photographs and machineries which tells a story about the origins and growth of tea plantations in Munnar.

Eravikulam National Park

Eravikulam National Park is one of the main attractions near Munnar. This park is famous for its endangered inhabitant - the Nilgiri Tahr. Spreading over an area of 97 sq. km, park is also home to several species of rare butterflies, birds and animals. The park offers a magnificent view of the tea plantations covered by blankets of mists. The National Park is renowned for its Neelakurinji flower that blooms once in twelve years and attracts numerous tourists from around the globe.

Anamudi Peak

Anamudi Peak standing at a height of 2700m is the highest peak in South India. Located inside the Eravikulam National Park, trekking to the Anamudi Peak is full of adventute and thrill. Standing on the peak can make you feel like that you can literally touch the the sky.

You can collect numerous spices like ginger, cardamom, pepper, cinnamon, coffee, clove. Do not miss the home-backed chocolates here.
