DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN LEH

It is one of the magnificent Tibetan structures that have ever been built. The architecture and the beauty of this place are unexplainable. Shanti Stupa is a white-dome structure dedicated to Buddhism.

Located on the hilltop of Chamspa in Leh, it is one of the major tourist attractions of Ladakh not only for its religious significance for also for its splendid views of the surrounding mountain ranges that it has to offer.

Overnight, stay at the hotel after delicious dinner.

DAY 02 INDUS VALLEY SIGHTSEEING

On this day after delicious breakfast, you will go for sightseeing tour to some ancient monasteries and most popular in this area. In this sightseeing tour, you will cover below beautiful destinations.

Shey Gompa: It is located at a solitary hillock at a distance of 15 km away south of Leh. It was once the residence of the royal family which was got constructed by the first king of Ladakh, Lhachen Palgyigon. According to tradition, it was the seat of temporal power of the pre-Tidetan kings. The main attraction in Shey Monastery is twelve feet Shakyamuni Buddha's statue. It is made of moulding copper and is the largest statue in the region.

Thinksey Gompa: Thinksey Gompa is a gompa of Tibetan Buddhism religion. It is located on the top of the hill. It is very famous for its similarity with Potala Palace of Lhasa. This is famous for pilgrim activities, exploration, architectural elements, and sightseeing. It has an interesting anecdote of how it was built in this exact location.

Hemis Monastery: Hemis monastery is one of the popular tourist destinations in Ladakh. This monastery is stationed on the west bank of the peaceful river Indus. The location lies 45 km from Leh city. This is the largest as well as most favored monastery in Ladakh was constructed in 1672 AD under the reign of King Singge Namgyal.

After that, back to hotel and stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 03

LEH-KHARDUNG LA (18380fts)—Leh (58kms) (3-4hrs)

In the morning after delicious breakfast, you will drive for the Khardung-La-Pass. It is the highest motorable road in the world taking you to a dizzy 5,600m! On top of the view is spectacular, stretching from the Indus valley in the South over the endless peaks and ridges of the Zanskar range to the giants of the Sesser Massif in the North. You can feel proud of a true achievement as you finish the trip with your final satisfying descent. Evening shopping and move around market Car will drop you to the Market you have to go back to the hotel by exploring.

After dinner, overnight stay at the hotel.
