## **Advisor Expectations:**

- 1. There is a zero-tolerance policy for gambling, drugs, vaping, alcohol,
- Tobacco, or marijuana usage at any point over the course of the program.
- 2. No touching between genders. Yachad staff may not have extended physical contact with any participant (i.e.- sitting on laps, holding hands, tickling, etc.).
- 3. Dress Code (for males and females): knees and shoulders must be covered.

Shabbos Attire for males is collared shirt and pants.

Shabbos Attire for females is skirts or dresses that reach the knee.

- 4. Everyone is expected to follow the schedule to the best of their ability and meaningfully contribute to the program/ environment.
- 5. Yachad is a department of the Orthodox Union and follows the strict adherence of Orthodox halacha. Our programs are run in a shomer Torah and Mitzvot fashion and under guidance of our posek, Rav Shay Schachter.
- 6. Yachad Staff may not be alone 1:1 with a Yachad participant in a non-public space or a room with a closed or locked door. Yachad Staff and any participants should always interact in a manner where they are both observable and interruptible.
  - 7. Yachad Staff are not permitted to share beds with participants under any circumstances.
