



 - Takes Years of Dedicated Work, But Worth It









THE REWARDS

Removed large tumor from lower jaw of larger patient. Surgery went well, but during healing he had difficulty breathing. Because of patient's size, anesthesia team was unable to place breathing tube. Performed emergent tracheostomy and saved his life!

- Help families find schools that will offer their specific student scholarship money/APPLY




















