### DEGREE IN THREE

CCU offers the accelerated undergraduate Degree in Three program (only for first-year freshmen). A student who enrolls in this program can earn a Bachelor of Science or a Bachelor of Arts in three years by taking classes in the fall, spring and summer semesters. The following majors currently offer accelerated Degree in Three programs. ### GET MORE IN FOUR

The Get More in Four program is a four-year combined undergraduate and graduate-level degree program in which students complete the Degree in Three program plus a one-year graduate degree. This accelerated degree program is only available for first-year freshmen.

Unlike traditional undergraduate/graduate programs that take five years, Coastal Carolina University's accelerated program is finished in

less time but with no less of an education. Bright, career-oriented and high-achieving students can complete the coursework for a Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts in three years by taking an accelerated schedule that includes courses during the fall, spring and summer semesters, and then moving immediately into the full-time graduate program. Interested students must first select the Degree in Three program and indicate interest in the Get More in Four program on the application for admission. Admittance into the Get More in Four program includes pre-admission to the graduate program and allows you to waive all graduate program entrance exams (e.g., GMAT, GRE). Students must apply for full admission to the graduate degree program following the regular deadlines. Other admission criteria specific to each program (e.g., minimum undergraduate GPA) apply.

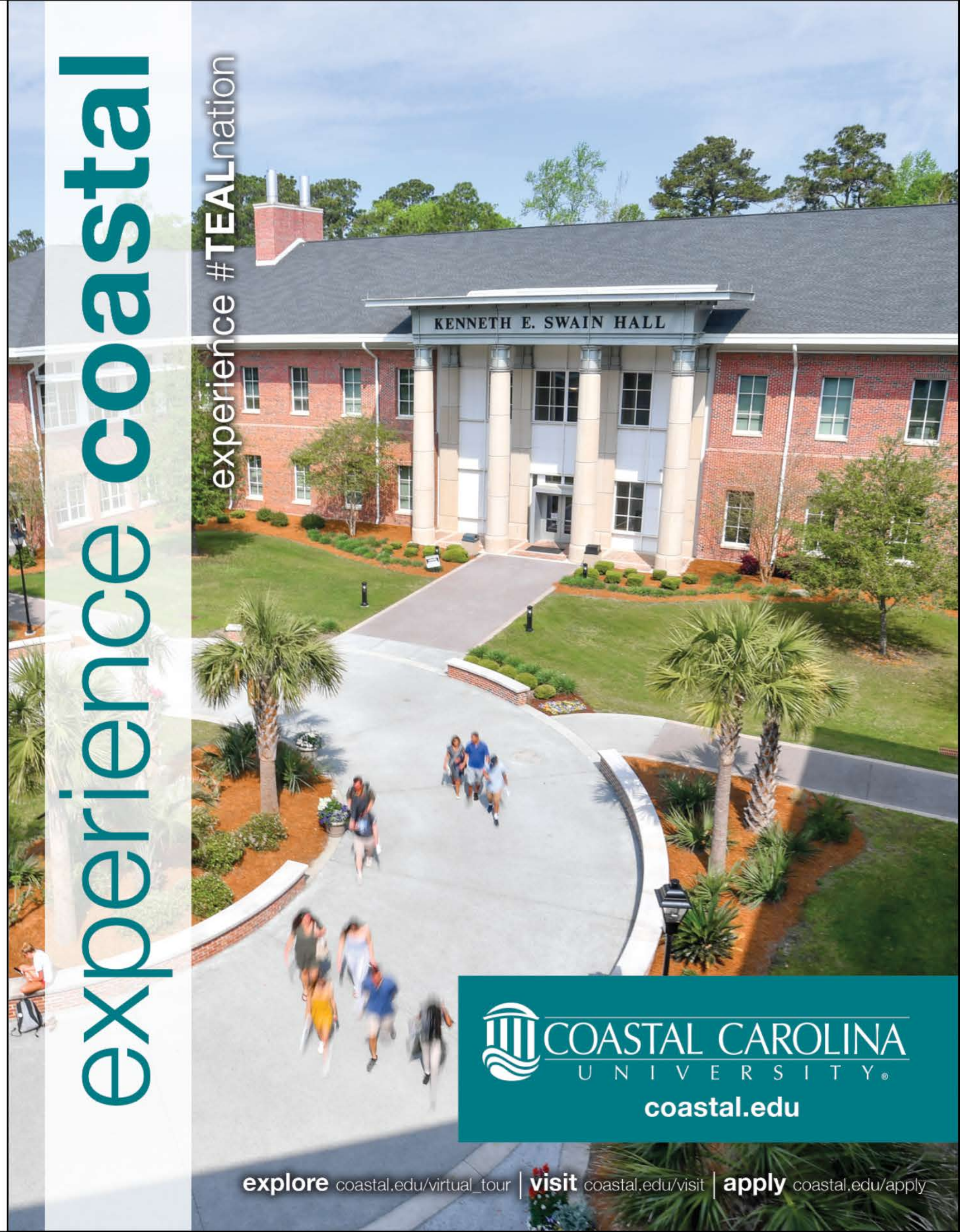

**FRESHMEN**

- Submit official high school transcripts.
- Submit SAT or ACT scores directly from testing agency.

The priority application date for freshman admission, merit award and scholarship consideration is **Dec. 1**.

**TRANSFER STUDENTS**

- Complete the online transfer application and pay the \$45 application fee.
- Submit official university transcripts from all institutions attended.
- Students who will transfer with fewer than 24 transferable credits must also submit official high school transcripts and SAT or ACT exam scores.

The priority application date for transfer admission, merit award and scholarship consideration is **June 1**.
