Requirements – D.D.S.

1. Basic Admission Requirements

A. Academic

- o A minimum of 90 semester hours of course work from any accredited college or university.
- o A minimum of 75 semester hours of course work prior to application.
- o A minimum grade point average of 2.50 for all college level work attempted.
- o Recommended 2.5 math and science GPA for all college level work attempted.
- o In good standing with the college or university last attended or in which currently enrolled.
