# Gamelan Dharma Swara

## CURATOR / GAMELAN ENSEMBLE

Dynamic coalition of musicians, dancers, and composers presenting Balinese performing arts

- ◆ Established in **1989 in New York City**, its players perform on **gamelan *semara dana* instruments** made by Balinese *pande* (blacksmith) Made Sukerta in 2017
- ◆ Appeared at **New Music Gathering**, Spring Revolution Festival at National Sawdust, **Basilica Soundscape**, and others
- ◆ In 2010 was **the first Western ensemble** to be invited to perform in the **Bali Arts Festival's popular *gong kebyar battle-of-the-bands***-style competition
- ◆ Plays works by both Balinese artists — e.g., **I Dewa Ketut Alit** and I Gusti Nyoman Darta — and American composers, including Matthew Welch, Joel Mellin, and **Vivian Fung**
- ◆ Performed at **(le) Poisson Rouge**, Symphony Space, Asia Society, BAM, MoMA, and **The Met Museum**, etc.
- ◆ ***Gendér wayang*** is a small ensemble of 2–4 metallophones that traditionally accompanies shadow puppetry and rituals; you'll experience it in three numbers tonight



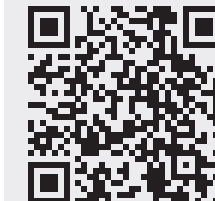
