OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY RESIDENCY 2023

Jaap van Zweden conducts the New York Philharmonic in three programs during its third residency at The McKnight Center for the Performing Arts at Oklahoma State University (OSU), in Stillwater, Oklahoma, September 22–24, 2023. Jeff Tyzik will conduct film score selections on one concert; the soloists featured in the concerts are violinist Stefan Jackiw, Principal Trumpet Christopher Martin, and pianist Anne-Marie McDermott. After inaugurating The McKnight Center in 2019, the two organizations have forged a three-year collaboration, which began in September 2022. The residency will include educational opportunities for OSU students to work with Philharmonic musicians, including in master classes.
