Brian's latest effort needs special recognition in that they just completed a 3 DEP QL1 LIDAR and 3" GSD (4 band ortho) project to support their spatial operations and planning functions. This is primarily one person being able to effectively communicate GIS needs to his department heads and council to secure funding to sustain their vital GIS operations.

All, along, Brian has been extremely involved in the foundation of WNYGIS User Group, was its president for over 4 years and currently serves on the group's steering committee.
