Dr. Emily Fogarty is an accomplished Assistant Professor at Farmingdale State College on Long Island. She has over a decade of experience in teaching the geospatial science of geography—at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Throughout her career, she has enriched the lives of students, educators, and scientists through her tireless efforts. She has also been instrumental in building the GIS curriculum at SUNY Farmingdale and is a champion for GIS across Long Island through her membership on the Long Island GIS Steering Committee.
