The project entailed multiple drinking water supply assessments at locations across New York State, with the effort distributed amongst three different GIS project Teams. The GIS activities are actively supporting lead planners and stakeholders with maps and data visualizations intended to improve local protection plans for drinking water supplies. Projects ranged from large urban townships like Brookhaven to small rural townships like Silver Springs. Becky's efforts to establish standardization and coordination across all projects have lead to reduced costs and improved quality in delivering key support to a critical statewide public health protection program.
