- Valuable Items (such as jewelry or large sums of cash)
- George Foreman Grill and other cooking appliances that could create a mess in a non-kitchen area
- Microwave — each hall has microwaves for student use
- Firearms or other weapons
- Fireworks of any kind
- Candles and incense
- Halogen lamps
- Pets (other than fish)
- Color-catching washer sheets and detergent/softener sheets — these get stuck in the washing machine filters and ruin the machines)
- Wireless internet routers — wireless internet is available throughout campus; outside routers interfere with the internet connection
