



Camper Agreement

I am excited about joining Camp Dror as a camper. I want to make sure that I have the best experience and that all my fellow campers and the staff have a great experience too. To ensure that camp is fun for everyone, I understand that I am obligated to follow all rules and regulations of Camp Director and the staff. I recognize that I am part of the Camp Dror family and I will make sure that I participate appropriately in the entire program including:

- o Behaving politely, kindly, and patiently to campers and staff
- o Dressing according to the required camp dress code
 - Girls must wear shirts with sleeves close to the elbow (no cap sleeves or sleeveless), skirts that reach the knees
 - Boys must wear a kippa or a cap, tzitzit, pants or shorts
 - **No cutting or modifying the camp shirts.** If you cut the shirt or modify it, you will need to buy a new one.
- o Speaking appropriately at all times- no screaming at others, teasing, bullying, or inappropriate language
- o Putting in an effort to create a good atmosphere
- o Keeping the camp environment clean
 - Ensuring that all camp equipment I use is cared for properly and returned to its rightful place
 - Keeping my room and belongings neat
- o Going to sleep at the scheduled time
- o Getting up in the morning on time according to the planned daily schedule
- o Being on time and participating in tefilla
- o Remaining with my group during their activities and actively participating with them
- o Remaining in the dining room during meal times and participating in the mealtime festivities and activities
- o Disconnecting from screens and connecting to life by being an active participant in all camp activities - I know that I am only permitted to use my phone for a limited time on Friday before Shabbat.



- I know that if I am not feeling well I should approach my counselor immediately.
- I understand that it is important to share with counselors if I know of dangerous or inappropriate behavior.
- I understand that physical contact of any kind with campers or staff is prohibited unless there is a safety situation which requires immediate intervention
- I understand that possession of weapons (pocket knives), cigarettes (e-cig or regular), vapes, alcohol, or drugs is grounds for immediate removal from camp
- I know that I must behave appropriately at all times including in the way I speak and my actions, whether a staff member is present or not.
- I undertake to comply with all guidelines of the Ministry of Education
- I understand that the camp administration reserves the right to send me home from camp if I do not comply with the camp rules.

Remember, if something's on your mind, it's important to share it. Your thoughts matter, and the staff is here to listen. We believe in open communication and working together to create a fantastic camp adventure for everyone!
