



California Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

July 1, 2026

To whom it may concern,

California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65"), codified at California Health and Safety Code Section 25249.6, requires that businesses provide a prior warning before knowingly and intentionally exposing individuals to chemicals that are listed by the State of California as known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

The California Attorney General has taken the position that entities within the distribution chain, including manufacturers and distributors, have an obligation to communicate applicable warning requirements and to take reasonable steps to facilitate compliance by downstream purchasers and end users.

OSG manufactures products intended for industrial applications and use in accordance with recognized operating practices. OSG does not control or anticipate all possible uses of our products, including unintended uses, such as grinding, which may generate airborne particles.

Based on information currently available and under ordinary conditions of intended use, OSG does not anticipate that its products give rise to exposure conditions requiring warnings under Proposition 65. However, OSG does not control and cannot reasonably foresee all conditions of handling, processing, modification, or use—including activities performed by third parties, such as grinding, reconditioning, or other material-altering operations—which may create conditions where exposure to substances subject to Proposition 65 could occur.

Accordingly, and without conceding that any warning is required for products as sold, OSG is providing general Proposition 65 warning materials to customers located in the State of California as a prudent measure to support awareness and regulatory compliance. Distributors, resellers, and end users are solely responsible for evaluating their specific operations, use conditions, and applicable legal obligations, and for determining whether warnings are required, and if so, for ensuring that such warnings are provided in accordance with applicable law.
