

## Shmuel II Perek 1

- After the death of King Shaul, and Dovid's victory against the Amaleiki, Dovid returned to Tsiklag, his place of residence.
- An Amaleiki man, wearing torn clothing and covered with dirt, came to Dovid and related the tragedy of the deaths of King Shaul and Yonason.
- The Amaleiki man was carrying King Shaul's royal crown and bracelet.
- The Amaleiki man told how he had personally killed King Shaul (Note: this is seemingly in contradiction with the account of King Shaul dying in Shmuel I Perek 31. Radak and Abarbanel suggest that this man was just filling in the details of what had happened.)
- Dovid ordered the Amaleiki man to be killed.
- Dovid lamented the deaths of King Shaul and Yonason.
