This week's פָּרְשָׁה ends with the story of בּּיְנְחָס who witnessed a terrible breech in the קְּדֶשׁ קַ קּדְשָׁר. He took a spear in his hand and, with holy zeal, killed בְּלָל יִשְׂרְאֵל together with שֵׁבֶּט שִׁמְעוֹן דֹּס נָשִׂיא the איַמְרָי together with בַּת צוּר , the daughter of the king of מוֹאָב. This zealous act of killing קֹשֵׁם, broke the plague that had caused 24,000 people from בְּלֵל יִשְׂרָאֵל to die.

Although פִּנְּחָס was the son of אָבְּעֹזָר and the grandchild of אַבְּעֹז, he was not a פָּרָשַׁת פִּינְחָס at that time. Only later on (in פָּרָשַׁת פִּינְחָס) was he rewarded by יד with the extra קְדָשֶׁח of becoming a פָּהָן. His other cousins, who were born after אַהָּרֹן was anointed as הָבָּהְ , received their status and honor of being a מַבְּין through their lineage to מִשְּהַרֹן. 
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## Gedolim Glimpses

In his famous רַמְבַּיין, אָגֵּרָת writes: "עַנֵיה is the finest of all admirable traits." A בַּעֵל נְאֲוָה is selfish and self-centered. He is unconcerned and out of touch with the feelings and needs of other people. By contrast, an ענו is always aware of other people's sensitivities and needs. The ענו seeks to honor others at every opportunity and is pleasant to everyone in every situation.

Rabbi Yaakov Bender related the following story:

My parents used to spend their summers in a bungalow colony which had many outstanding קלמידי חַכְמִים among its residents. Among these תַּלְמִידֵי חֲכָמִים was a wheelchair bound invalid who had suffered a stroke at a relatively young age.

Every summer, Rav Moshe Feinstein, זָצִייל, would come to visit this תַּלְמִיד חַכֶּם. We always had advance notice of Rav Moshe's visit and I can assure you that the day of his visit was a sort of "יוֹם טוֹב" for us. All the boys wore white shirts, and everyone waited with anticipation for the גַּדוֹל הַדוֹר to arrive.

A semi-circle of lawn chairs would be arranged for these occasions, as many of the renowned "scholars in residence" would join Rav Moshe and the invalid whom he had come to visit. They would sit and discuss תּוֹרָה topics, as everyone else looked on in respectful awe and silence.

One year, not long after the men were seated, a number of boys approached and began to snap pictures. Flashbulbs popped repeatedly, until, finally, one of the older men called out, "Enough, enough already! Stop talking pictures!"

Rav Moshe, however, smiled in his very sweet, kind way, and said, (in Yiddish), "They are children, and they want to take pictures — let them!"

Then, this צַדִּיק and צַדָּיק did something that no one present will ever forget. Rav Moshe smoothed out his frock, sat up straight, and smiled wide as he posed for the many pictures that the young photographers proceeded to snap.

#### An **Ahavas Chesed** Moment

\*The closer a relative, the higher the level of precedence when it comes to performing any מֶּסֶד. Therefore, if a father and a brother come for a loan together, the father has precedence. If a רָבִּי and a father both ask for a loan, then, depending on the circumstances, the יְבֶּי takes precedence, for a רָבִּי brings a person to חַיֵּי עוֹלָם הָבַּא, life in the World-To-Come. However, if the father and רֵבִּי are equal in תּוֹרָה knowledge or the father had paid for the רָבִּי, then the father takes precedence, for the father is also credited for his son's חַיֵּי עוֹלָם הָבָּא.

\*This is intended only as a guide. Please review any real-life situations with a competent Rov.

The חֶבֶּץ חַיִּים explains that all the הֲלָכוֹת of precedence are to be applied only if the חֶבֶּץ חַיִּים has no monetary loss associated with it. If by being kind to an עני, the person has a loss of profit on a business opportunity with the עָשִׁיר, then it depends on whether the significant loss would make a real difference in his life.

#### יייז תמויז

ייז תַּמוּז is second only to טי בָּאָב as a day of national tragedy. Although the גביאִים ordained it as a fast day to commemorate its role in the destruction of the בֵּית הַמְקְדָּשׁ, it simultaneously recalls four other sad events, all of which are mentioned in the סליחות that we recite on this day. The five tragedies of this day are: (1) משה רבינו broke the first set of לוחות when he came down from הַר סִינֵי and found בָּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל worshipping the עֵגֵל הַזָּהָב. (2) During בַּיִת. ran out of sheep for the קרבּן תָמִיד and בָּבל was able to breach the wall surrounding יְרוּשֶׁלַיִם. (3) During יִרוּשֻלַיִם, the wall of יַרוּשֻלַיִם was breached on this day. (4) During בַּיִת שֶׁנִי a סֶבֶּר תּוֹרָה was burned in public by the Roman officer Apostomos. (5) An idol was placed in the בֵּית הַמְּקְדָּשׁ.
